

# ALL THE COMMANDS OF CHRIST AND THE GOSPEL

185 Commands of Jesus  
(see Online Bible 5794 - Mood Imperative)

*For this is the love of God, that we keep his commandments:  
and his commandments are not burdensome. – 1 John 5:3*

*He that has my commandments, and keeps them,  
he it is that loves me; and he that loves me shall be loved of my Father,  
and I will love him, and will manifest myself to him. – John 14:21*

*He that loveth me not keeps not my sayings:  
and the word which you hear is not mine,  
but the Father's which sent me. – John 14:24*

This is a compilation of the direct commands of Christ, which He made to either His disciples, the Pharisees, or the public. We Christians tell a lot of Bible stories, and we learn a lot about Christ's life, but we do not always take time to reflect on the commands He has given. Christ tells us not only what to do, but also how to think. – **Compiled by Skylar Burris (without references)**

## Dealing With Others

1. Matthew 5:25 Agree with your adversary quickly, while you art in the way with him: lest at any time the adversary deliver you to the judge. (i.e. settle out of court)
2. Matthew 18:15 If your brother shall trespass against you, go and tell him his fault between you and him alone...if he will not hear you, then take with you one or two more...and if he shall neglect to hear them, tell it unto the church; but if he neglect to hear the church, let him be unto you as a heathen man and a publican.
3. Mark 8:15 Take heed and beware of the leaven of the Sadducees and the Pharisees.
4. Matthew 5:34 Swear not at all; neither by heaven...nor by the earth...neither by Jerusalem...neither shall you swear by your head...but let your communication be Yea, yea: Nay, Nay. (i.e. If you honor your word consistently, others will believe you without an oath. If you don't, an oath is meaningless.)
5. Matthew 5:39 Resist not evil: but whosoever shall smite thee on the right cheek, turn to him the other also. And if any man will sue you at the law, and take away your coat, let him have your cloak also. And whosoever shall compel you to go a mile, go with him twain.
6. Mark 9:39 Forbid him not [said of a man not belonging to their group who was casting out devils in Jesus's name]: for he that is not against us is for us.
7. Luke 12:4 Be not afraid of them that kill the body, but can not kill the soul. Fear him, which after he has killed have power to cast into hell: yea, I say unto you, fear him.
8. Mark 13:5 Take heed lest any man deceive you
9. Luke 10:27 You shall love your neighbor as yourself
10. Matthew 5:42 Give to him that asks of you, and from him that would borrow of you turn not you away
11. Matthew 5:44 Love your enemies, bless them that curse you, do good to them that hate you, and pray for them which despiteful use you and persecute you
12. Matthew 7:1 Judge not, that you be not judged. First cast out the beam in your own eye, and then shall you see clearly to cast out the mote in your brother's eye.
13. Matthew 7:6 Give not that which is holy unto the dogs, neither cast you your pearls before swine.
14. Matthew 7:12 All things whatsoever you would that men should do to you, do you even so to them.
15. Matthew 7:15 Beware of false prophets
16. Matthew 10:8 Freely you have received; freely give.

## Worship and Prayer

17. Matthew 5:23 If you bring your gift to the altar, and there remember that your brother has ought against you: Leave there your gift before the altar, and go your way: first be reconciled to your brother, and then come and offer your gift.
18. Matthew 6:1 Take heed that you do not your alms before men, to be seen of them...but when you doest alms, let not your left hand know what your right hand does.
19. Matthew 6:6 When you pray, enter into your closet, and when you hast shut your door, pray.

20. Matthew 6:7 And when you pray you shall not be as the hypocrites are: for they love to pray standing in the synagogues and the corners of streets to be seen of men.
21. Matthew 6:7 But when you pray, use not vain repetition.
22. Matthew 6:9 After this manner therefore pray: Our Father which art in heaven....
23. Matthew 6:16 Moreover when you fast, be not, as the hypocrites, of a sad countenance: for they disfigure their faces that they may appear to men to fast. But you, when you fast, anoint your head, and wash your face; that you appear not unto men to fast.
24. Mark 11:25 When you stand praying forgive, if you have ought against any: that your Father also which is in heaven may forgive you. But if you do not forgive, neither will your father which is in heaven forgive you.

### **Proper Thinking**

25. Mark 13:33 Take ye heed, watch and pray: for you know not when the time is / Watch you and pray, lest you enter into temptation
26. Matthew 5:17 Think not that I am come to destroy the law and the prophets: I am come not to destroy, but to fulfill
27. Matthew 9:13 Go ye and learn what this means: "I will have mercy, and not sacrifice."
28. Matthew 10:34 Think not that I am come to send peace on earth: I come not to send peace, but a sword.
29. Luke 9:44 Let these sayings sink down into your ears
30. Matthew 4:17 Repent: for the Kingdom of heaven is at hand
31. Matthew 8:22 Follow me: and let the dead bury the dead
32. Matthew 7:13 Enter ye in at the strait gate

### **Responding to God - Money**

39. Matthew 5:16 Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven
40. Matthew 9:38 Pray ye therefore the Lord of the harvest, that he will send forth laborers into the harvest
41. Matthew 10:27 What I tell you in the darkness, that speak ye in the light: and what you hear in the ear, that preach ye upon the housetops
42. Mark 16:15 Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature

47. Matthew 5:48 Be you perfect, even as your Father which is in heaven is perfect. (word translated perfect here is Greek for "mature")

50. 53. Mark 10:19 Do not kill
51. 54. Mark 10:19 Do not bear false witness
52. 55. Mark 10:19 Defraud not
53. 56. Luke 12:15 Take heed, and beware of covetousness
54. 57. Luke 12:32 Fear not, little flock
55. Matthew 5:29 If your right eye offend you, pluck it out. If your right hand offend you, cut it off (we take this symbolically of course)

69. 1 John 3:24 And he that keeps his commandments dwelleth in him, and he in him. And hereby we know that he abides in us, by the Spirit which he has given us.
70. 1 John 5:2 By this we know that we love the children of God, when we love God, and keep his commandments.
71. 2 John 1:6 And this is love, that we walk after his commandments. This is the commandment, That, as you have heard from the beginning, you should walk in it.
72. Revelation 22:14 Blessed *are* they that do his commandments, that they may have right to the tree of life, and may enter in through the gates into the city.
73. Matthew 19:13 Suffer the little children to come unto me and forbid them not for such is the kingdom of heaven. Mk 10:14/Lk 18:16

74. Matthew 5:12 Rejoice, and be exceeding glad: for great is your reward in heaven (to all those persecuted for His sake)
75. Matthew 26:26 Take, eat this is my body. / This is my body which is given for you. Do this in remembrance of me.
76. Matthew 11:28 Come unto me, all you that labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you, and learn of me...and you shall have rest in your souls.



## Other Commands of Jesus

### Beware

77. Matthew 7:15 Beware of false prophets, which come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravening wolves.
78. Matthew 10:17 But beware of men: for they will deliver you up to the councils, and they will scourge you in their synagogues;
79. Matthew 16:6 Then Jesus said unto them, Take heed and beware of the leaven of the Pharisees and of the Sadducees.
80. Matthew 16:11 How is it that you do not understand that I spoke *it* not to you concerning bread, that you should beware of the leaven of the Pharisees and of the Sadducees?
81. Matthew 16:12 Then understood they how that he bade *them* not beware of the leaven of bread, but of the doctrine of the Pharisees and of the Sadducees.
82. Mark 8:15 And he charged them, saying, Take heed, beware of the leaven of the Pharisees, and *of* the leaven of Herod.
83. Mark 12:38 And he said unto them in his doctrine, Beware of the scribes, which love to go in long clothing, and *love* salutations in the marketplaces,
84. Luke 12:1 In the mean time, when there were gathered together an innumerable multitude of people, insomuch that they trode one upon another, he began to say unto his disciples first of all, Beware you of the leaven of the Pharisees, which is hypocrisy.
85. Luke 12:15 And he said unto them, Take heed, and beware of covetousness: for a man's life consisteth not in the abundance of the things which he possesseth.
86. Luke 20:46 Beware of the scribes, which desire to walk in long robes, and love greetings in the markets, and the highest seats in the synagogues, and the chief rooms at feasts;

### Take Heed

87. Matthew 6:1 Take heed that you do not your alms before men, to be seen of them: otherwise you have no reward of your Father which is in heaven.
88. Matthew 16:6 Then Jesus said unto them, Take heed and beware of the leaven of the Pharisees and of the Sadducees.
89. Matthew 18:10 Take heed that you despise not one of these little ones; for I say unto you, That in heaven their angels do always behold the face of my Father which is in heaven.
90. Matthew 24:4 And Jesus answered and said unto them, Take heed that no man deceive you.
91. Mark 4:24 And he said unto them, Take heed what you hear: with what measure you mete, it shall be measured to you: and unto you that hear shall more be given.
92. Mark 8:15 And he charged them, saying, Take heed, beware of the leaven of the Pharisees, and *of* the leaven of Herod.
93. Mark 13:5 And Jesus answering them began to say, Take heed lest any *man* deceive you:
94. Mark 13:9 But take heed to yourselves: for they shall deliver you up to councils; and in the synagogues you shall be beaten: and you shall be brought before rulers and kings for my sake, for a testimony against them.
95. Luke 8:18 Take heed therefore how you hear: for whosoever has, to him shall be given; and whosoever has not, from him shall be taken even that which he seemeth to have.
96. Luke 11:35 Take heed therefore that the light which is in you be not darkness.
97. Luke 12:15 And he said unto them, Take heed, and beware of covetousness: for a man's life consisteth not in the abundance of the things which he possesseth.
98. Luke 17:3 Take heed to yourselves: If your brother trespass against you, rebuke him; and if he repent, forgive him.
99. Luke 21:8 And he said, Take heed that you be not deceived: for many shall come in my name, saying, I am *Christ*; and the time draweth near: go you not therefore after them.
100. Luke 21:34 And take heed to yourselves, lest at any time your hearts be overcharged with surfeiting, and drunkenness, and cares of this life, and *so* that day come upon you unawares.

104. John 16:4 But these things have I told you, that when the time shall come, you may [remember](#) that I told you of them. And these things I said not unto you at the beginning, because I was with you.

105. Matthew 4:7 Jesus said unto him, It is written again, You [shall not](#) tempt the Lord your God.
106. Matthew 5:21 you have heard that it was said by them of old time, You [shall not](#) kill; and whosoever shall kill shall be in danger of the judgment:
107. Matthew 5:27 you have heard that it was said by them of old time, You [shall not](#) commit adultery:
108. Matthew 5:33 Again, you have heard that it has been said by them of old time, You [shall not](#) forswear yourself, but shall perform unto the Lord your oaths:
109. Matthew 6:5 And when you pray, you [shall not](#) be as the hypocrites *are*: for they love to pray standing in the synagogues and in the corners of the streets, that they may be seen of men. Verily I say unto you, They have their reward.
110. Luke 4:12 And Jesus answering said unto him, It is said, You [shall not](#) tempt the Lord your God.

### **Come Unto Me**

111. Matthew 11:28 [Come unto me](#), all you that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.
112. Matthew 19:14 But Jesus said, Suffer little children, and forbid them not, to [come unto me](#): for of such is the kingdom of heaven.
113. Mark 10:14 But when Jesus saw *it*, he was much displeased, and said unto them, Suffer the little children to [come unto me](#), and forbid them not: for of such is the kingdom of God.
114. Luke 18:16 But Jesus called them *unto him*, and said, Suffer little children to [come unto me](#), and forbid them not: for of such is the kingdom of God.
115. John 6:65 And he said, Therefore said I unto you, that no man can [come unto me](#), except it were given unto him of my Father.
116. John 7:37 In the last day, that great *day* of the feast, Jesus stood and cried, saying, If any man thirst, let him [come unto me](#), and drink.

### **Follow Me**

117. Matthew 4:19 And he said unto them, [Follow me](#), and I will make you fishers of men.
118. Matthew 8:22 But Jesus said unto him, [Follow me](#): and let the dead bury their dead.
119. Matthew 9:9 And as Jesus passed forth from thence, he saw a man, named Matthew, sitting at the receipt of custom: and he said unto him, [Follow me](#). And he arose, and followed him.
120. Matthew 16:24 Then said Jesus unto his disciples, If any *man* will come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and [follow me](#).
121. Matthew 19:21 Jesus said unto him, If you wilt be perfect, go *and* sell that you hast, and give to the poor, and you shall have treasure in heaven: and come *and* [follow me](#).
122. Mark 2:14 And as he passed by, he saw Levi the *son* of Alphaeus sitting at the receipt of custom, and said unto him, [Follow me](#). And he arose and followed him.
123. Mark 8:34 And when he had called the people *unto him* with his disciples also, he said unto them, Whosoever will come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and [follow me](#).
124. Mark 10:21 Then Jesus beholding him loved him, and said unto him, One thing you lackest: go your way, sell whatsoever you hast, and give to the poor, and you shall have treasure in heaven: and come, take up the cross, and [follow me](#).
125. Luke 5:27 And after these things he went forth, and saw a publican, named Levi, sitting at the receipt of custom: and he said unto him, [Follow me](#).
126. Luke 9:23 And he said to *them* all, If any *man* will come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross daily, and [follow me](#).
127. Luke 9:59 And he said unto another, [Follow me](#). But he said, Lord, suffer me first to go and bury my father.
128. Luke 18:22 Now when Jesus heard these things, he said unto him, Yet lackest you one thing: sell all that you hast, and distribute unto the poor, and you shall have treasure in heaven: and come, [follow me](#).

129. John 1:43 The day following Jesus would go forth into Galilee, and findeth Philip, and said unto him, Follow me.
130. John 10:27 My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me:
131. John 12:26 If any man serve me, let him follow me; and where I am, there shall also my servant be: if any man serve me, him will *my* Father honour.
132. John 13:36 Simon Peter said unto him, Lord, whither goest you? Jesus answered him, Whither I go, you canst not follow me now; but you shall follow me afterwards.
133. John 21:19 This spake he, signifying by what death he should glorify God. And when he had spoken this, he said unto him, Follow me.

### Do NOT

134. Matthew 5:46 For if you love them which love you, what reward have ye? do not even the publicans the same?
135. Matthew 5:47 And if you salute your brethren only, what do you more *than others*? do not even the publicans so?
136. Matthew 6:1 Take heed that you do not your alms before men, to be seen of them: otherwise you have no reward of your Father which is in heaven.
137. Matthew 6:2 Therefore when you doest *your* alms, do not sound a trumpet before you, as the hypocrites do in the synagogues and in the streets, that they may have glory of men. Verily I say unto you, They have their reward.
138. Matthew 6:20 But lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust doth corrupt, and where thieves do not break through nor steal:
139. Matthew 23:3 All therefore whatsoever they bid you observe, *that* observe and do; but do not you after their works: for they say, and do not.
140. Mark 10:19 You knowest the commandments, Do not commit adultery, Do not kill, Do not steal, Do not bear false witness, Defraud not, Honour your father and mother.
141. Mark 11:26 But if you do not forgive, neither will your Father which is in heaven forgive your trespasses.
142. Luke 6:46 And why call you me, Lord, Lord, and do not the things which I say?
143. Luke 12:56 you hypocrites, you can discern the face of the sky and of the earth; but how is it that you do not discern this time?
144. Luke 18:20 You know the commandments, Do not commit adultery, Do not kill, Do not steal, Do not bear false witness, Honor your father and your mother.
145. John 5:45 Do not think that I will accuse you to the Father: there is *one* that accuses you, *even* Moses, in whom you trust.
146. John 10:37 If I do not the works of my Father, believe me not.
147. Revelation 3:18 I counsel you to buy of me gold tried in the fire, that you may be rich; and white raiment, that you may be clothed, and *that* the shame of your nakedness do not appear; and anoint your eyes with eyesalve, that you may see.

### Go - (discern who to do what, disciples, individual, etc.)

148. Matthew 5:24 Leave there your gift before the altar, and go your way; first be reconciled to your brother, and then come and offer your gift.
149. Matthew 5:41 And whosoever shall compel you to go a mile, go with him twain.
150. Matthew 7:13 Enter you in at the strait gate: for wide *is* the gate, and broad *is* the way, that leadeth to destruction, and many there be which go in thereat:
151. Matthew 8:4 And Jesus said unto him, See you tell no man; but go your way, shew yourself to the priest, and offer the gift that Moses commanded, for a testimony unto them.
152. Matthew 9:6 But that you may know that the Son of man has power on earth to forgive sins, (then said he to the sick of the palsy,) Arise, take up your bed, and go unto your house.
153. Matthew 9:13 But go you and learn what *that* meaneth, I will have mercy, and not sacrifice: for I am not come to call the righteous, but sinners to repentance.
154. Matthew 10:5 These twelve Jesus sent forth, and commanded them, saying, Go not into the way of the Gentiles, and into *any* city of the Samaritans enter you not:
155. Matthew 10:6 But go rather to the lost sheep of the house of Israel.
156. Matthew 10:7 And as you go, preach, saying, The kingdom of heaven is at hand.
157. Matthew 10:11 And into whatsoever city or town you shall enter, enquire who in it is *wor*your; and there abide till you go thence.

158. Matthew 18:15 Moreover if your brother shall trespass against you, go and tell him his fault between you and him alone: if he shall hear you, you hast gained your brother.
159. Matthew 19:21 Jesus said unto him, If you wilt be perfect, go and sell that you hast, and give to the poor, and you shall have treasure in heaven: and come *and* follow me.
160. Matthew 19:24 And again I say unto you, It is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle, than for a rich man to enter into the kingdom of God.
161. Matthew 22:9 Go you therefore into the highways, and as many as you shall find, bid to the marriage.
162. Matthew 24:26 Wherefore if they shall say unto you, Behold, he is in the desert; go not forth: behold, *he is* in the secret chambers; believe *it* not.
163. Matthew 26:18 And he said, Go into the city to such a man, and say unto him, The Master said, My time is at hand; I will keep the passover at your house with my disciples.
164. Matthew 28:19 Go you therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost:
165. Mark 5:19 Howbeit Jesus suffered him not, but said unto him, Go home to your friends, and tell them how great things the Lord has done for you, and has had compassion on you.
166. Mark 6:38 He said unto them, How many loaves have ye? go and see. And when they knew, they say, Five, and two fishes.
167. Mark 8:26 And he sent him away to his house, saying, Neither go into the town, nor tell *it* to any in the town.
168. Mark 9:43 And if your hand offend you, cut it off: it is better for you to enter into life maimed, than having two hands to go into hell, into the fire that never shall be quenched:
169. Mark 10:21 Then Jesus beholding him loved him, and said unto him, One thing you lackest: go your way, sell whatsoever you hast, and give to the poor, and you shall have treasure in heaven: and come, take up the cross, and follow me.
170. Mark 10:25 It is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle, than for a rich man to enter into the kingdom of God.
171. Mark 10:52 And Jesus said unto him, Go your way; your faith has made you whole. And immediately he received his sight, and followed Jesus in the way.
172. Mark 13:15 And let him that is on the housetop not go down into the house, neither enter *therein*, to take any thing out of his house:
173. Mark 16:15 And he said unto them, Go you into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature.
174. Luke 9:5 And whosoever will not receive you, when you go out of that city, shake off the very dust from your feet for a testimony against them.
175. Luke 9:60 Jesus said unto him, Let the dead bury their dead: but go you and preach the kingdom of God.
176. Luke 10:3 Go your ways: behold, I send you forth as lambs among wolves.
177. Luke 10:7 And in the same house remain, eating and drinking such things as they give: for the labourer is worthy of his hire. Go not from house to house.
178. Luke 10:10 But into whatsoever city you enter, and they receive you not, go your ways out into the streets of the same, and say,
179. Luke 10:37 And he said, He that shewed mercy on him. Then said Jesus unto him, Go, and do you likewise.
180. Luke 14:10 But when you art bidden, go and sit down in the lowest room; that when he that bade you cometh, he may say unto you, Friend, go up higher: then shall you have worship in the presence of them that sit at meat with you.
181. Luke 14:23 And the lord said unto the servant, Go out into the highways and hedges, and compel *them* to come in, that my house may be filled.
182. John 8:11 She said, No man, Lord. And Jesus said unto her, Neither do I condemn you: go, and sin no more.
183. John 15:16 you have not chosen me, but I have chosen you, and ordained you, that you should go and bring forth fruit, and *that* your fruit should remain: that whatsoever you shall ask of the Father in my name, he may give it you.

#### **From the Lord**

184. 1 Corinthians 7:10 And unto the married I command, *yet* not I, but the Lord, Let not the wife depart from *her* husband:

185. 1 Thessalonians 4:2 For you know what commandments we gave you by the Lord Jesus.
