

Scarlet Thread of Redemption

From the beginning of human history, the dying of the innocent for the guilty is revealed. After Adam and Eve sinned, God shed innocent blood to make clothes for them to cover the shame of their nakedness. From that blood covering in the Garden of Eden to the blood-washed multitude standing before the throne of God in Revelation 19, the sacrifice of blood can be traced.

1. Genesis 3:15 - Woman bruise, crush
2. Genesis 3:21 Skins slain to cover shame
3. Genesis 22 – Isaac – The Lord will provide a Lamb – on the Mt it will be provided

Genesis 3:15 – Her offspring (one man) will crush Satan’s his head

And I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your offspring and hers; he (Jesus) will crush your head, and you (Satan) will strike his heel."

Genesis 3: 21 – God killed animals to provide a covering

The LORD God made garments of skin for Adam and his wife and clothed them.

Genesis 22:8 – God provides a Lamb

Abraham answered, "God himself will provide the lamb for the burnt offering, my son." And the two of them went on together. 13 Abraham looked up and there in a thicket he saw a ram caught by its horns. He went over and took the ram and sacrificed it as a burnt offering instead of his son. 14. So Abraham called that place The LORD Will Provide. And to this day it is said, "On the mountain of the LORD it will be provided."

Exodus 12:13 – The Blood of the Passover Lamb

Exodus 12:13 When I see the blood I will pass over you.

Exodus 30:10 – The Day of Atonement, with the blood of the atoning sin offering

Once a year Aaron shall make atonement on its horns. This annual atonement must be made with the blood of the atoning sin offering for the generations to come. It is most holy to the LORD."

Numbers 21:4-9 – The Brazen Serpent

So Moses made a bronze snake and put it up on a pole. Then when anyone was bitten by a snake and looked at the bronze snake, he lived.

Joshua 2:18 – Rahab's Scarlet Cord

When we enter the land, you have tied this scarlet cord in the window through which you let us down, and unless you have brought your father and mother, your brothers and all your family into your house.

Psalms 22:16-18 – David – They pierced my hands and my feet

They have pierced my hands and my feet. I can count all my bones; people stare and gloat over me. They divide my garments among them and cast lots for my clothing.

Psalms 53:2, 8-10, 16-17 – David – No sacrifice - Purge me with hyssop

Wash away all my iniquity and cleanse me from my sin. 8. Let me hear joy and gladness; let the bones you have crushed rejoice. 9. Hide your face from my sins and blot out all my iniquity. 10. Create in me a pure heart, O God, You do not delight in sacrifice, or I would bring it; you do not take pleasure in burnt offerings. The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit; a broken and contrite heart, O God, you will not despise.

Isaiah 53:3-5 – He was bruised for our iniquities

He was despised and rejected by men, a man of sorrows, and familiar with suffering. Like one from whom men hide their faces he was despised, and we esteemed him not. 4. Surely he took up our infirmities and carried our sorrows, yet we considered him stricken by God, smitten by him, and afflicted. 5. But he was pierced for our transgressions, he was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was upon him, and by his wounds we are healed.

Daniel 9:25-26 – Messiah will be cut off – sacrifice shall cease

Know and understand this: From the issuing of the decree to restore and rebuild Jerusalem until the **Anointed One, the ruler**, comes, there will be seven 'sevens,' and sixty-two 'sevens.' It will be rebuilt with streets and a trench, but in times of trouble. 26. After the sixty-two 'sevens,' **the Anointed One will be cut off and will have nothing**. The people of the ruler who will come will destroy the city and the sanctuary. The end will come like a flood: War will continue until the end, and desolations have been decreed. 27. He will confirm a covenant with many for one 'seven.' **In the middle of the 'seven' he will put an end to sacrifice and offering.**

Zechariah 3:3-5 – filthy garments, a brand plucked out of fire - take off, put on

Now Joshua was dressed in filthy clothes as he stood before the angel. 4. The angel said to those who were standing before him, "**Take off his filthy clothes.**" **Then he said to Joshua, "See, I have taken away your sin, and I will put rich garments on you."** 5. Then I said, "Put a clean turban on his head." So they put a clean turban on his head and clothed him, while the angel of the LORD stood by.

Zechariah 12:10 – They looked on him whom they pierced

And I will pour out on the house of David and the inhabitants of Jerusalem a spirit of grace and supplication. **They will look on me, the one they have pierced**, and they will mourn for him as one mourns for an only child, and grieve bitterly for him as one grieves for a firstborn son.

Zechariah 13:1 – A fountain opened for sin and for uncleanness.

On that day a fountain will be opened to the house of David and the inhabitants of Jerusalem, to cleanse them from sin and impurity.

John 1:29, 36 – Behold the Lamb of God

The next day John saw Jesus coming toward him and said, "Look, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world! 36 And looking upon Jesus as he walked, he said, [Behold the Lamb](#) of God!

John 3:14-16 – God so loved the world that he gave his only Son

Just as Moses lifted up the snake in the desert, so the Son of Man must be lifted up, 15. that everyone who believes in him may have eternal life. 16. "For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life.

John 19:16-19 – They crucified him. He said, "It is finished."

Finally Pilate handed him over to them to be crucified. So the soldiers took charge of Jesus. 17. Carrying his own cross, he went out to the place of the Skull (which in Aramaic is called Golgotha). 18. Here they crucified him, and with him two others--one on each side and Jesus in the middle. 19. Pilate had a notice prepared and fastened to the cross. It read: JESUS OF NAZARETH, THE KING OF THE JEWS. When he had received the drink, Jesus said, "It is finished." With that, he bowed his head and gave up his spirit.

Luke 22:20 – New Testament in my blood

This cup is the [new testament](#) in my blood, which is shed for you. Matthew 26:29 I will not drink henceforth of this fruit of the vine, until that day when I drink it new with you [in my Father's kingdom](#).

Romans 5:8-9 – Justified by His blood

But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us. 9. Since we have now been justified by his blood, how much more shall we be saved from God's wrath through him!

1 Corinthians 1:18 – Preaching of the Cross

For the preaching of the [cross](#) is to them that perish foolishness; but unto us which are saved it is the power of God.

Galatians 6:14 – Glory save in the Cross

But God forbid that I should glory, save in the [cross](#) of our Lord Jesus Christ, by whom the world is crucified unto me, and I unto the world.

Colossians 1:20 – Peace through the blood of the cross

And, having made peace through the blood of his [cross](#), by him to reconcile all things unto himself;

Colossians 2:14 – Our guilt He nailed to the cross

Blotting out the handwriting of ordinances that was against us, which was contrary to us, and took it out of the way, nailing it to his [cross](#);

Hebrews 9:22 - Without the shedding of blood, no remission of sin

And almost all things are by the law purged with [blood](#); and without shedding of [blood](#) is no remission.

Hebrews 10:4 – Impossible for blood of bulls and goats to take away sin

For *it is* not possible that the [blood](#) of bulls and of goats should take away sins.

Hebrews 10:19 – Boldness to enter the holy of holies by the blood of Jesus

Having therefore, brethren, boldness to enter into the holiest by the [blood](#) of Jesus,

Revelation 1:5 – Freed us from our sins by his blood

To him who loves us and has freed us from our sins by his blood,

Revelation 5:9 – Purchased with His blood

And they sang a new song: "You are worthy to take the scroll and to open its seals, because you were slain, and with your blood you purchased men for God from every tribe and language and people and nation.

Revelation 7:14 – Robes washed white in the blood of the Lamb

These are they who have come out of the great tribulation; they have washed their robes and made them white in the blood of the Lamb.

Revelation 12:11 – Overcame him through the blood of the Lamb

They overcame him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony; they did not love their lives so much as to shrink from death.

Revelation 19:13-14 – Dressed in a robe dripped in blood.

He is dressed in a robe dipped in blood, and his name is the Word of God. 14 The armies of heaven were following him, riding on white horses and dressed in fine linen, white and clean.
