## **LESSON 11**

# **Inductive Study of the Ten Plagues**

Exodus 7:14-10:2 & 12:29-36

According to Exodus 12:12 the plagues of Egypt were against all the gods of the Egyptians. God was bringing judgment of the gods and the spirit/demons represented by them. Remember that all the gods of the Egyptians and all idols are demons, not gods. There were over 2,000 gods in Egypt. Some Egyptologist say there were 3,000 gods.

"On that same night I will pass through Egypt and strike down every firstborn-both men and animals--and I will bring judgment on all the gods of Egypt. I am the LORD." – **Exodus 12:12** 

As you read through this extended passage I would like for you to be an alert reading looking for certain things that are significant.

#### Look for Pharaoh's Hardened Heart

There are by my count 16 instances of him hardening his heart or God hardening his heart. We will be studying this next week, so it is important that you find these passages. Not the difference when Pharaoh hardened his own heart and when God said He hardened Pharaoh's heart. Write a line from the Scripture.
