Pharaoh's Hardened Heart

An In-depth Study of Exodus 7-14

- 1. Ex 4:21 And the LORD said unto Moses, When you go to return into Egypt, see that you do all those wonders before Pharaoh, which I have put in your hand: but I will https://personable.com/harden his heart, that heart, heart, heart</
- 2. Ex 7:3 And I will <u>harden</u> Pharaoh's heart, and multiply my signs and my wonders in the land of Egypt.
- 3. Ex 7:13 And he <u>hardened</u> Pharaoh's heart, that <u>he did not hearken</u> unto them; as the LORD had said.
- 4. Ex 7:14 And the LORD said unto Moses, Pharaoh's heart *is* **hardened**, he refuses to let the people go.
- 5. Ex 7:22 And the magicians of Egypt did so with their enchantments: and Pharaoh's heart was **hardened**, neither did he hearken unto them; as the LORD had said.
- 6. Ex 8:15 But when Pharaoh saw that there was respite, he **hardened** his heart, and hearkened not unto them; as the LORD had said.
- 7. Ex 8:19 Then the magicians said unto Pharaoh, This *is* the finger of God: and Pharaoh's heart was **hardened**, and he <u>hearkened not</u> unto them; as the LORD had said.
- 8. Ex 8:32 And Pharaoh <u>hardened</u> his heart at this time also, <u>neither would he</u> <u>let</u> the people go.
- 9. Ex 9:7 And Pharaoh sent, and, behold, there was not one of the cattle of the Israelites dead. And the heart of Pharaoh was **hardened**, and he did not let the people go.
- 10.Ex 9:12 And **the LORD** <u>hardened</u> the heart of Pharaoh, and he <u>hearkened</u> not unto them; as the LORD had spoken unto Moses.
- 11. Ex 9:34 And when Pharaoh saw that the rain and the hail and the thunders were ceased, <u>he sinned yet more</u>, and <u>hardened</u> his heart, he and his servants.
- 12. Ex 9:35 And the heart of Pharaoh was <u>hardened</u>, <u>neither would he let</u> the children of Israel go; as the LORD had spoken by Moses.
- 13. Ex 10:1 And the LORD said unto Moses, Go in unto Pharaoh: for **I have** hardened his heart, and the heart of his servants, that I might show these my signs before him:
- 14. Ex 10:20 But **the LORD** <u>hardened</u> Pharaoh's heart, so that <u>he would not let</u> the children of Israel go.
- 15. Ex 10:27 But the LORD <u>hardened</u> Pharaoh's heart, and <u>he would not let</u> them go.

- 16. Ex 11:10 And Moses and Aaron did all these wonders before Pharaoh: and **the LORD** <u>hardened</u> Pharaoh's heart, so that <u>he would not let</u> the children of Israel go out of his land.
- 17.Ex 14:8 And the LORD <u>hardened</u> the heart of Pharaoh king of Egypt, and <u>he pursued after</u> the children of Israel: and the children of Israel went out with a high hand.
- 18. Ex 14:4 And I will <u>harden</u> Pharaoh's heart, that <u>he will follow after</u> them; and I will be honored upon Pharaoh, and upon all his host; that the Egyptians may know that I *am* the LORD. And they did so.
- 19.Ex 14:17 And I, behold, I will <u>harden</u> the hearts of the Egyptians, and <u>they</u> will follow them: and I will get me honor upon Pharaoh, and upon all his host, upon his chariots, and upon his horsemen.

Note the adamant refusal to obey the LORD.

- 10 Times it says the Lord hardened his heart. 8 times Pharaoh hardened his own heart.
 - He would not let...8x
 - He hearken not ...4x
 - He refused ...1x
 - He sinned more and more...1x
 - He followed them... 1x
 - He pursued them... 2x
