- Exodus 4:21 And the LORD said unto Moses, When thou goest to return into Egypt, see that thou do all those wonders before Pharaoh, which I have put in thine hand: but I will <u>harden</u> his heart, that he shall not let the people go.
- Exodus 7:3 And I will <u>harden</u> Pharaoh's heart, and multiply my signs and my wonders in the land of Egypt.
- Exodus 14:4 And I will <u>harden</u> Pharaoh's heart, that he shall follow after them; and I will be honoured upon Pharaoh, and upon all his host; that the Egyptians may know that I *am* the LORD. And they did so.
- Exodus 14:17 And I, behold, I will <u>harden</u> the hearts of the Egyptians, and they shall follow them: and I will get me honour upon Pharaoh, and upon all his host, upon his chariots, and upon his horsemen.

- Exodus 33:3 Unto a land flowing with milk and honey: for I will not go up in the midst of thee; for thou *art* a <u>stiffnecked</u> people: lest I consume thee in the way.
- Exodus 33:5 For the LORD had said unto Moses, Say unto the children of Israel, Ye *are* a <u>stiffnecked</u> people: I will come up into the midst of thee in a moment, and consume thee: therefore now put off thy ornaments from thee, that I may know what to do unto thee.
- Exodus 34:9 And he said, If now I have found grace in thy sight, O Lord, let my Lord, I pray thee, go among us; for it *is* a <u>stiffnecked</u> people; and pardon our iniquity and our sin, and take us for thine inheritance.

Acts 7:51 Ye <u>stiffnecked</u> <4644> and uncircumcised in heart and ears, ye do always resist the Holy Ghost: as your fathers *did*, so *do* ye.

- Acts 9:5 And he said, Who art thou, Lord? And the Lord said, I am Jesus whom thou persecutest: *it is* hard <4642> for thee to kick against the pricks.
- Acts 26:14 And when we were all fallen to the earth, I heard a voice speaking unto me, and saying in the Hebrew tongue, Saul, Saul, why persecutest thou me? *it is* hard <4642> for thee to kick against the pricks.

- Mark 6:52 For they considered not *the miracle* of the loaves: for their heart was hardened <4456>.
- Mark 8:17 And when Jesus knew *it*, he saith unto them, Why reason ye, because ye have no bread? perceive ye not yet, neither understand? have ye your heart yet hardened <4456>?
- John 12:40 He hath blinded their eyes, and hardened <4456> their heart; that they should not see with *their* eyes, nor understand with *their* heart, and be converted, and I should heal them.
- Romans 11:7 What then? Israel hath not obtained that which he seeketh for; but the election hath obtained it, and the rest were blinded <4456>
- 2 Corinthians 3:14 But their minds were blinded <4456>: for until this day remaineth the same veil untaken away in the reading of the old testament; which *veil* is done away in Christ.
