# Word Studies of Horeb/Sinai

# **Mount Horeb**

- Exodus 3:1 ¶ Now Moses kept the flock of Jethro his father in law, the priest of Midian: and he led the flock to the backside of the desert, and came to the mountain of God, *even* to <u>Horeb</u>.
- Exodus 17:6 Behold, I will stand before thee there upon the rock in <u>Horeb</u>; and thou shalt smite the rock, and there shall come water out of it, that the people may drink. And Moses did so in the sight of the elders of Israel.
- Exodus 33:6 And the children of Israel stripped themselves of their ornaments by the mount <u>Horeb</u>.
- Deuteronomy 1:2 (*There are* eleven days' *journey* from <u>Horeb</u> by the way of mount Seir unto Kadeshbarnea.)
- Deuteronomy 1:6 The LORD our God spake unto us in <u>Horeb</u>, saying, Ye have dwelt long enough in this mount:
- Deuteronomy 1:19 ¶ And when we departed from <u>Horeb</u>, we went through all that great and terrible wilderness, which ye saw by the way of the mountain of the Amorites, as the LORD our God commanded us; and we came to Kadeshbarnea.
- Deuteronomy 4:10 *Specially* the day that thou stoodest before the LORD thy God in <u>Horeb</u>, when the LORD said unto me, Gather me the people together, and I will make them hear my words, that they may learn to fear me all the days that they shall live upon the earth, and *that* they may teach their children.
- Deuteronomy 4:15 Take ye therefore good heed unto yourselves; for ye saw no manner of similitude on the day *that* the LORD spake unto you in <u>Horeb</u> out of the midst of the fire:
- Deuteronomy 5:2 The LORD our God made a covenant with us in Horeb.
- Deuteronomy 9:8 Also in <u>Horeb</u> ye provoked the LORD to wrath, so that the LORD was angry with you to have destroyed you.
- Deuteronomy 18:16 According to all that thou desiredst of the LORD thy God in <u>Horeb</u> in the day of the assembly, saying, Let me not hear again the voice of the LORD my God, neither let me see this great fire any more, that I die not.
- Deuteronomy 29:1 ¶ These *are* the words of the covenant, which the LORD commanded Moses to make with the children of Israel in the land of Moab, beside the covenant which he made with them in <u>Horeb</u>.
- 1 Kings 8:9 *There was* nothing in the ark save the two tables of stone, which Moses put there at <u>Horeb</u>, when the LORD made *a covenant* with the children of Israel, when they came out of the land of Egypt.
- 1 Kings 19:8 And he arose, and did eat and drink, and went in the strength of that meat forty days and forty nights unto <u>Horeb</u> the mount of God.

2 Chronicles 5:10 *There was* nothing in the ark save the two tables which Moses put *therein* at <u>Horeb</u>, when the LORD made *a covenant* with the children of Israel, when they came out of Egypt.

Psalms 106:19 They made a calf in Horeb, and worshipped the molten image.

Malachi 4:4 ¶ Remember ye the law of Moses my servant, which I commanded unto him in <u>Horeb</u> for all Israel, *with* the statutes and judgments.

# **Mount Sinai**

- Exodus 19:11 And be ready against the third day: for the third day the LORD will come down in the sight of all the people upon <u>mount Sinai</u>.
- Exodus 19:18 And <u>mount Sinai</u> was altogether on a smoke, because the LORD descended upon it in fire: and the smoke thereof ascended as the smoke of a furnace, and the whole mount quaked greatly.
- Exodus 19:20 And the LORD came down upon <u>mount Sinai</u>, on the top of the mount: and the LORD called Moses *up* to the top of the mount; and Moses went up.
- Exodus 19:23 And Moses said unto the LORD, The people cannot come up to <u>mount Sinai</u>: for thou chargedst us, saying, Set bounds about the mount, and sanctify it.
- Exodus 24:16 And the glory of the LORD abode upon <u>mount Sinai</u>, and the cloud covered it six days: and the seventh day he called unto Moses out of the midst of the cloud.
- Exodus 31:18 And he gave unto Moses, when he had made an end of communing with him upon <u>mount Sinai</u>, two tables of testimony, tables of stone, written with the finger of God.
- Exodus 34:2 And be ready in the morning, and come up in the morning unto <u>mount Sinai</u>, and present thyself there to me in the top of the mount.
- Exodus 34:4 And he hewed two tables of stone like unto the first; and Moses rose up early in the morning, and went up unto <u>mount Sinai</u>, as the LORD had commanded him, and took in his hand the two tables of stone.
- Exodus 34:29 And it came to pass, when Moses came down from <u>mount Sinai</u> with the two tables of testimony in Moses' hand, when he came down from the mount, that Moses wist not that the skin of his face shone while he talked with him.
- Exodus 34:32 And afterward all the children of Israel came nigh: and he gave them in commandment all that the LORD had spoken with him in <u>mount Sinai</u>.
- Leviticus 7:38 Which the LORD commanded Moses in <u>mount Sinai</u>, in the day that he commanded the children of Israel to offer their oblations unto the LORD, in the wilderness of Sinai.
- Leviticus 25:1 ¶ And the LORD spake unto Moses in mount Sinai, saying,

- Leviticus 26:46 These *are* the statutes and judgments and laws, which the LORD made between him and the children of Israel in <u>mount Sinai</u> by the hand of Moses.
- Leviticus 27:34 These *are* the commandments, which the LORD commanded Moses for the children of Israel in <u>mount Sinai</u>.
- Numbers 3:1 ¶ These also *are* the generations of Aaron and Moses in the day *that* the LORD spake with Moses in <u>mount Sinai</u>.
- Numbers 28:6 *It is* a continual burnt offering, which was ordained in <u>mount Sinai</u> for a sweet savour, a sacrifice made by fire unto the LORD.
- Nehemiah 9:13 Thou camest down also upon <u>mount Sinai</u>, and spakest with them from heaven, and gavest them right judgments, and true laws, good statutes and commandments:
- Galatians 4:24 Which things are an allegory: for these are the two covenants; the one from the <u>mount Sinai</u>, which gendereth to bondage, which is Agar.
- Galatians 4:25 For this Agar is <u>mount Sinai</u> in Arabia, and answereth to Jerusalem which now is, and is in bondage with her children

### Sinai

- Exodus 16:1 ¶ And they took their journey from Elim, and all the congregation of the children of Israel came unto the wilderness of Sin, which *is* between Elim and <u>Sinai</u>, on the fifteenth day of the second month after their departing out of the land of Egypt.
- Exodus 19:1 ¶ In the third month, when the children of Israel were gone forth out of the land of Egypt, the same day came they *into* the wilderness of <u>Sinai</u>.
- Exodus 19:2 For they were departed from Rephidim, and were come *to* the desert of <u>Sinai</u>, and had pitched in the wilderness; and there Israel camped before the mount.
- Exodus 19:11 And be ready against the third day: for the third day the LORD will come down in the sight of all the people upon mount <u>Sinai</u>.
- Exodus 19:18 And mount <u>Sinai</u> was altogether on a smoke, because the LORD descended upon it in fire: and the smoke thereof ascended as the smoke of a furnace, and the whole mount quaked greatly.

- Leviticus 25:1 ¶ And the LORD spake unto Moses in mount Sinai, saying,
- Leviticus 26:46 These *are* the statutes and judgments and laws, which the LORD made between him and the children of Israel in mount <u>Sinai</u> by the hand of Moses.
- Leviticus 27:34 These *are* the commandments, which the LORD commanded Moses for the children of Israel in mount <u>Sinai</u>.
- Numbers 1:1 ¶ And the LORD spake unto Moses in the wilderness of <u>Sinai</u>, in the tabernacle of the congregation, on the first *day* of the second month, in the second year after they were come out of the land of Egypt, saying,
- Numbers 1:19 As the LORD commanded Moses, so he numbered them in the wilderness of <u>Sinai</u>.
- Numbers 3:1 ¶ These also *are* the generations of Aaron and Moses in the day *that* the LORD spake with Moses in mount <u>Sinai</u>.
- Numbers 3:4 And Nadab and Abihu died before the LORD, when they offered strange fire before the LORD, in the wilderness of <u>Sinai</u>, and they had no children: and Eleazar and Ithamar ministered in the priest's office in the sight of Aaron their father.
- Numbers 3:14 ¶ And the LORD spake unto Moses in the wilderness of Sinai, saying,
- Numbers 9:1 ¶ And the LORD spake unto Moses in the wilderness of <u>Sinai</u>, in the first month of the second year after they were come out of the land of Egypt, saying,
- Numbers 9:5 And they kept the passover on the fourteenth day of the first month at even in the wilderness of <u>Sinai</u>: according to all that the LORD commanded Moses, so did the children of Israel.

Numbers 10:12 And the children of Israel took their journeys out of the wilderness of <u>Sinai</u>; and the cloud rested in the wilderness of Paran.

- Numbers 26:64 But among these there was not a man of them whom Moses and Aaron the priest numbered, when they numbered the children of Israel in the wilderness of <u>Sinai</u>.
- Numbers 28:6 *It is* a continual burnt offering, which was ordained in mount <u>Sinai</u> for a sweet savour, a sacrifice made by fire unto the LORD.
- Numbers 33:15 And they departed from Rephidim, and pitched in the wilderness of <u>Sinai</u>.
- Numbers 33:16 And they removed from the desert of <u>Sinai</u>, and pitched at **Kibrothhattaavah.**
- Deuteronomy 33:2 And he said, The LORD came from <u>Sinai</u>, and rose up from Seir unto them; he shined forth from mount Paran, and he came with ten thousands of saints: from his right hand *went* a fiery law for them.
- Judges 5:5 The mountains melted from before the LORD, *even* that <u>Sinai</u> from before the LORD God of Israel.
- Nehemiah 9:13 Thou camest down also upon mount <u>Sinai</u>, and spakest with them from heaven, and gavest them right judgments, and true laws, good statutes and commandments:
- Psalms 68:8 The earth shook, the heavens also dropped at the presence of God: even Sinai itself was moved at the presence of God, the God of Israel.
- Psalms 68:17 The chariots of God *are* twenty thousand, *even* thousands of angels: the Lord *is* among them, *as in* <u>Sinai</u>, in the holy *place*.
- Galatians 4:24 Which things are an allegory: for these are the two covenants; the one from the mount <u>Sinai</u>, which gendereth to bondage, which is Agar.
  - Galatians 4:25 For this Agar is **mount** <u>Sinai</u> in Arabia, and answers to Jerusalem which now is, and is in bondage with her children.
