# Circumcision/Circumcise(d)

### Circumcision

Exodus 4:26 So he let him go: then she said, A bloody husband thou art, because of the circumcision.

#### **New Testament**

- John 7:22 Moses therefore gave unto you <u>circumcision</u>; (not because it is of Moses, but of the fathers;) and ye on the sabbath day circumcise a man.
- John 7:23 If a man on the sabbath day receive <u>circumcision</u>, that the law of Moses should not be broken; are ye angry at me, because I have made a man every whit whole on the sabbath day?
- Acts 7:8 And he gave him the covenant of <u>circumcision</u>: and so *Abraham* begat Isaac, and circumcised him the eighth day; and Isaac *begat* Jacob; and Jacob *begat* the twelve patriarchs.
- Acts 10:45 And they of the <u>circumcision</u> which believed were astonished, as many as came with Peter, because that on the Gentiles also was poured out the gift of the Holy Ghost.
- Acts 11:2 And when Peter was come up to Jerusalem, they that were of the <u>circumcision</u> contended with him,
- Romans 2:25 For <u>circumcision</u> verily profiteth, if thou keep the law: but if thou be a breaker of the law, thy <u>circumcision</u> is made uncircumcision.
- Romans 2:26 Therefore if the uncircumcision keep the righteousness of the law, shall not his uncircumcision be counted for circumcision?
- Romans 2:27 And shall not uncircumcision which is by nature, if it fulfil the law, judge thee, who by the letter and circumcision dost transgress the law?
- Romans 2:28 For he is not a Jew, which is one outwardly; neither *is that* <u>circumcision</u>, which is outward in the flesh:
- Romans 2:29 But he *is* a Jew, which is one inwardly; and <u>circumcision</u> *is that* of the heart, in the spirit, and not in the letter; whose praise *is* not of men, but of God.
- Romans 3:1 ¶ What advantage then hath the Jew? or what profit is there of circumcision?
- Romans 3:30 Seeing *it is* one God, which shall justify the <u>circumcision</u> by faith, and uncircumcision through faith.
- Romans 4:9 ¶ *Cometh* this blessedness then upon the <u>circumcision</u> *only*, or upon the uncircumcision also? for we say that faith was reckoned to Abraham for righteousness.
- Romans 4:10 How was it then reckoned? when he was in <u>circumcision</u>, or in uncircumcision? Not in <u>circumcision</u>, but in uncircumcision.
- Romans 4:11 And he received the sign of <u>circumcision</u>, a seal of the righteousness of the faith which *he had yet* being uncircumcised: that he might be the father of all them that believe, though they be not circumcised; that righteousness might be imputed unto them also:
- Romans 4:12 And the father of <u>circumcision</u> to them who are not of the <u>circumcision</u> only, but who also walk in the steps of that faith of our father Abraham, which *he had* being *yet* uncircumcised.
- Romans 15:8 Now I say that Jesus Christ was a minister of the <u>circumcision</u> for the truth of God, to confirm the promises *made* unto the fathers:
- 1 Corinthians 7:19 <u>Circumcision</u> is nothing, and uncircumcision is nothing, but the keeping of the commandments of God.
- Galatians 2:7 But contrariwise, when they saw that the gospel of the uncircumcision was committed unto me, as *the gospel* of the <u>circumcision</u> was unto Peter;
- Galatians 2:8 (For he that wrought effectually in Peter to the apostleship of the <u>circumcision</u>, the same was mighty in me toward the Gentiles:)
- Galatians 2:9 And when James, Cephas, and John, who seemed to be pillars, perceived the grace that was given unto me, they gave to me and Barnabas the right hands of fellowship; that we *should go* unto the heathen, and they unto the circumcision.
- Galatians 2:12 For before that certain came from James, he did eat with the Gentiles: but when they were come, he withdrew and separated himself, fearing them which were of the <u>circumcision</u>.
- Galatians 5:6 For in Jesus Christ neither <u>circumcision</u> availeth any thing, nor uncircumcision; but faith which worketh by love.
- Galatians 5:11 And I, brethren, if I yet preach <u>circumcision</u>, why do I yet suffer persecution? then is the offence of the cross ceased.

- Galatians 6:15 For in Christ Jesus neither <u>circumcision</u> availeth any thing, nor uncircumcision, but a new creature.
- Ephesians 2:11 ¶ Wherefore remember, that ye *being* in time past Gentiles in the flesh, who are called Uncircumcision by that which is called the Circumcision in the flesh made by hands;
- Philippians 3:3 For we are the <u>circumcision</u>, which worship God in the spirit, and rejoice in Christ Jesus, and have no confidence in the flesh.
- Colossians 2:11 In whom also ye are circumcised with the <u>circumcision</u> made without hands, in putting off the body of the sins of the flesh by the circumcision of Christ:
- Colossians 3:11 Where there is neither Greek nor Jew, <u>circumcision</u> nor uncircumcision, Barbarian, Scythian, bond *nor* free: but Christ *is* all, and in all.
- Colossians 4:11 And Jesus, which is called Justus, who are of the <u>circumcision</u>. These only *are my* fellowworkers unto the kingdom of God, which have been a comfort unto me.
- Titus 1:10 For there are many unruly and vain talkers and deceivers, specially they of the <u>circumcision</u>:

### Circumcise(d)

- Genesis 17:10 This *is* my covenant, which ye shall keep, between me and you and thy seed after thee; Every man child among you shall be circumcised.
- Genesis 17:11 And ye shall <u>circumcise</u> the flesh of your foreskin; and it shall be a token of the covenant betwixt me and you.
- Genesis 17:12 And he that is eight days old shall be <u>circumcised</u> among you, every man child in your generations, he that is born in the house, or bought with money of any stranger, which *is* not of thy seed.
- Genesis 17:13 He that is born in thy house, and he that is bought with thy money, must needs be circumcised: and my covenant shall be in your flesh for an everlasting covenant.
- Genesis 17:14 And the uncircumcised man child whose flesh of his foreskin is not <u>circumcised</u>, that soul shall be cut off from his people; he hath broken my covenant.
- Genesis 17:23 ¶ And Abraham took Ishmael his son, and all that were born in his house, and all that were bought with his money, every male among the men of Abraham's house; and <u>circumcised</u> the flesh of their foreskin in the selfsame day, as God had said unto him.
- Genesis 17:24 And Abraham was ninety years old and nine, when he was <u>circumcised</u> in the flesh of his foreskin.
- Genesis 17:25 And Ishmael his son *was* thirteen years old, when he was <u>circumcised</u> in the flesh of his foreskin.
- Genesis 17:26 In the selfsame day was Abraham circumcised, and Ishmael his son.
- Genesis 17:27 And all the men of his house, born in the house, and bought with money of the stranger, were <u>circumcised</u> with him.
- Genesis 21:4 And Abraham <u>circumcised</u> his son Isaac being eight days old, as God had commanded him.
- Genesis 34:15 But in this will we consent unto you: If ye will be as we *be*, that every male of you be <u>circumcised</u>;
- Genesis 34:17 But if ye will not hearken unto us, to be <u>circumcised</u>; then will we take our daughter, and we will be gone.
- Genesis 34:22 Only herein will the men consent unto us for to dwell with us, to be one people, if every male among us be <u>circumcised</u>, as they <u>are circumcised</u>.
- Genesis 34:24 And unto Hamor and unto Shechem his son hearkened all that went out of the gate of his city; and every male was <u>circumcised</u>, all that went out of the gate of his city.
- Exodus 12:44 But every man's servant that is bought for money, when thou hast <u>circumcised</u> him, then shall he eat thereof.
- Exodus 12:48 And when a stranger shall sojourn with thee, and will keep the passover to the LORD, let all his males be <u>circumcised</u>, and then let him come near and keep it; and he shall be as one that is born in the land: for no uncircumcised person shall eat thereof.
- Leviticus 12:3 And in the eighth day the flesh of his foreskin shall be circumcised.
- Deuteronomy 10:16 <u>Circumcise</u> therefore the foreskin of your heart, and be no more stiffnecked. Deuteronomy 30:6 And the LORD thy God will <u>circumcise</u> thine heart, and the heart of thy seed, to love the LORD thy God with all thine heart, and with all thy soul, that thou mayest live.

- Joshua 5:2 At that time the LORD said unto Joshua, Make thee sharp knives, and <u>circumcise</u> again the children of Israel the second time.
- Joshua 5:3 And Joshua made him sharp knives, and <u>circumcised</u> the children of Israel at the hill of the foreskins.
- Joshua 5:4 And this *is* the cause why Joshua did <u>circumcise</u>: All the people that came out of Egypt, *that were* males, *even* all the men of war, died in the wilderness by the way, after they came out of Egypt.
- Joshua 5:5 Now all the people that came out were <u>circumcised</u>: but all the people that were born in the wilderness by the way as they came forth out of Egypt, them they had not <u>circumcised</u>.
- Joshua 5:7 And their children, *whom* he raised up in their stead, them Joshua <u>circumcised</u>: for they were uncircumcised, because they had not <u>circumcised</u> them by the way.
- Jeremiah 4:4 <u>Circumcise</u> yourselves to the LORD, and take away the foreskins of your heart, ye men of Judah and inhabitants of Jerusalem: lest my fury come forth like fire, and burn that none can quench *it*, because of the evil of your doings.
- Jeremiah 9:25 Behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that I will punish all *them which are* <u>circumcised</u> with the uncircumcised:

#### **New Testament**

- Luke 1:59 And it came to pass, that on the eighth day they came to <u>circumcise</u> the child; and they called him Zacharias, after the name of his father.
- John 7:22 Moses therefore gave unto you circumcision; (not because it is of Moses, but of the fathers;) and ye on the sabbath day <u>circumcise</u> a man.
- Acts 7:8 And he gave him the covenant of circumcision: and so *Abraham* begat Isaac, and <u>circumcised</u> him the eighth day; and Isaac *begat* Jacob; and Jacob *begat* the twelve patriarchs.
- Acts 15:1 ¶ And certain men which came down from Judaea taught the brethren, *and said*, Except ye be <u>circumcised</u> after the manner of Moses, ye cannot be saved.
- Acts 15:5 But there rose up certain of the sect of the Pharisees which believed, saying, That it was needful to <u>circumcise</u> them, and to command *them* to keep the law of Moses.
- Acts 15:24 Forasmuch as we have heard, that certain which went out from us have troubled you with words, subverting your souls, saying, *Ye must* be <u>circumcised</u>, and keep the law: to whom we gave no *such* commandment:
- Acts 16:3 Him would Paul have to go forth with him; and took and <u>circumcised</u> him because of the Jews which were in those quarters: for they knew all that his father was a Greek.
- Acts 21:21 And they are informed of thee, that thou teachest all the Jews which are among the Gentiles to forsake Moses, saying that they ought not to <u>circumcise</u> *their* children, neither to walk after the customs.
- Romans 4:11 And he received the sign of circumcision, a seal of the righteousness of the faith which *he had yet* being uncircumcised: that he might be the father of all them that believe, though they be not <u>circumcised</u>; that righteousness might be imputed unto them also:
- 1 Corinthians 7:18 Is any man called being <u>circumcised</u>? let him not become uncircumcised. Is any called in uncircumcision? let him not be <u>circumcised</u>.
- Galatians 2:3 But neither Titus, who was with me, being a Greek, was compelled to be <u>circumcised</u>:
- Galatians 5:2 Behold, I Paul say unto you, that if ye be circumcised, Christ shall profit you nothing.
- Galatians 5:3 For I testify again to every man that is circumcised, that he is a debtor to do the whole law.
- Galatians 6:12 As many as desire to make a fair shew in the flesh, they constrain you to be <u>circumcised</u>; only lest they should suffer persecution for the cross of Christ.
- Galatians 6:13 For neither they themselves who are <u>circumcised</u> keep the law; but desire to have you circumcised, that they may glory in your flesh.
- Philippians 3:5 <u>Circumcised</u> the eighth day, of the stock of Israel, *of* the tribe of Benjamin, an Hebrew of the Hebrews; as touching the law, a Pharisee;
- Colossians 2:11 In whom also ye are <u>circumcised</u> with the circumcision made without hands, in putting off the body of the sins of the flesh by the circumcision of Christ:
