# "I Am the LORD!"

### Exodus = 17 x

- Exodus 6:2 And God spake unto Moses, and said unto him, **I AM THE LORD**
- Exodus 6:6 Wherefore say unto the children of Israel, <u>I AM THE LORD</u> and I will bring you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians, and I will rid you out of their bondage, and I will redeem you with a stretched out arm, and with great judgments:
- Exodus 6:7 And I will take you to me for a people, and I will be to you a God: and ye shall know that **I AM THE LORD** your God, which bringeth you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians.
- Exodus 6:8 And I will bring you in unto the land, concerning the which I did swear to give it to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob; and I will give it you for an heritage: **I AM THE LORD.**
- Exodus 6:29 That the LORD spake unto Moses, saying, **I AM THE LORD** speak thou unto Pharaoh king of Egypt all that I say unto thee.
- Exodus 7:5 And the Egyptians shall know that <u>I AM THE LORD</u> when I stretch forth mine hand upon Egypt, and bring out the children of Israel from among them.
- Exodus 7:17 Thus saith the LORD, In this thou shalt know that **I AM THE LORD** behold, I will smite with the rod that *is* in mine hand upon the waters which *are* in the river, and they shall be turned to blood.
- Exodus 8:22 And I will sever in that day the land of Goshen, in which my people dwell, that no swarms *of flies* shall be there; to the end thou mayest know that <u>I AM THE</u> <u>LORD</u> in the midst of the earth.
- Exodus 10:2 And that thou mayest tell in the ears of thy son, and of thy son's son, what things I have wrought in Egypt, and my signs which I have done among them; that ye may know how that **I AM THE LORD.**
- Exodus 12:12 For I will pass through the land of Egypt this night, and will smite all the firstborn in the land of Egypt, both man and beast; and against all the gods of Egypt I will execute judgment: **I AM THE LORD.**
- Exodus 14:4 And I will harden Pharaoh's heart, that he shall follow after them; and I will be honoured upon Pharaoh, and upon all his host; that the Egyptians may know that **I AM THE LORD.** And they did so.
- Exodus 14:18 And the Egyptians shall know that **I AM THE LORD** when I have gotten me honour upon Pharaoh, upon his chariots, and upon his horsemen.
- Exodus 15:26 And said, If thou wilt diligently hearken to the voice of the LORD thy God, and wilt do that which is right in his sight, and wilt give ear to his commandments, and keep all his statutes, I will put none of these diseases upon thee, which I have brought upon the Egyptians: for **I AM THE LORD** that healeth thee.
- Exodus 16:12 I have heard the murmurings of the children of Israel: speak unto them, saying, At even ye shall eat flesh, and in the morning ye shall be filled with bread; and ye shall know that **I AM THE LORD** your God.
- Exodus 20:2 **I AM THE LORD** thy God, which have brought thee out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of bondage.

- Exodus 29:46 And they shall know that <u>I AM THE LORD</u> their God, that brought them forth out of the land of Egypt, that I may dwell among them: <u>I AM THE LORD</u> their God
- Exodus 31:13 Speak thou also unto the children of Israel, saying, Verily my sabbaths ye shall keep: for it *is* a sign between me and you throughout your generations; that *ye* may know that **I AM THE LORD** that doth sanctify you.

#### Leviticus = 45x

- Leviticus 11:44 For **I AM THE LORD** your God: ye shall therefore sanctify yourselves, and ye shall be holy; for I *am* holy: neither shall ye defile yourselves with any manner of creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth.
- Leviticus 11:45 For <u>I AM THE LORD</u> that bringeth you up out of the land of Egypt, to be your God: ye shall therefore be holy, for I *am* holy.
- Leviticus 18:2 Speak unto the children of Israel, and say unto them, <u>I AM THE LORD</u> your God.
- Leviticus 18:4 Ye shall do my judgments, and keep mine ordinances, to walk therein: **I AM THE LORD** your God.
- Leviticus 18:5 Ye shall therefore keep my statutes, and my judgments: which if a man do, he shall live in them: **I AM THE LORD.**
- Leviticus 18:6 None of you shall approach to any that is near of kin to him, to uncover *their* nakedness: **I AM THE LORD.**
- Leviticus 18:21 And thou shalt not let any of thy seed pass through *the fire* to Molech, neither shalt thou profane the name of thy God: <u>I AM THE LORD.</u>
- Leviticus 18:30 Therefore shall ye keep mine ordinance, that *ye* commit not *any one* of these abominable customs, which were committed before you, and that ye defile not yourselves therein: **I AM THE LORD** your God.
- Leviticus 19:3 Ye shall fear every man his mother, and his father, and keep my sabbaths: **I AM THE LORD** your God.
- Leviticus 19:4 Turn ye not unto idols, nor make to yourselves molten gods: <u>I AM THE</u> <u>LORD</u> your God.
- Leviticus 19:10 And thou shalt not glean thy vineyard, neither shalt thou gather *every* grape of thy vineyard; thou shalt leave them for the poor and stranger: **I AM THE LORD** your God.
- Leviticus 19:12 And ye shall not swear by my name falsely, neither shalt thou profane the name of thy God: I AM THE LORD.
- Leviticus 19:14 Thou shalt not curse the deaf, nor put a stumblingblock before the blind, but shalt fear thy God: **I AM THE LORD.**
- Leviticus 19:16 Thou shalt not go up and down *as* a talebearer among thy people: neither shalt thou stand against the blood of thy neighbour: **I AM THE LORD.**
- Leviticus 19:18 Thou shalt not avenge, nor bear any grudge against the children of thy people, but thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself: **I AM THE LORD.**
- Leviticus 19:25 And in the fifth year shall ye eat of the fruit thereof, that it may yield unto you the increase thereof: **I AM THE LORD** your God.
- Leviticus 19:28 Ye shall not make any cuttings in your flesh for the dead, nor print any marks upon you: **I AM THE LORD.**

- Leviticus 19:30 Ye shall keep my sabbaths, and reverence my sanctuary: **I AM THE LORD.**
- Leviticus 19:31 Regard not them that have familiar spirits, neither seek after wizards, to be defiled by them: **I AM THE LORD** your God.
- Leviticus 19:32 Thou shalt rise up before the hoary head, and honour the face of the old man, and fear thy God: <u>I AM THE LORD.</u>
- Leviticus 19:34 *But* the stranger that dwelleth with you shall be unto you as one born among you, and thou shalt love him as thyself; for ye were strangers in the land of Egypt: **I AM THE LORD** your God.
- Leviticus 19:36 Just balances, just weights, a just ephah, and a just hin, shall ye have: **I AM THE LORD** your God, which brought you out of the land of Egypt.
- Leviticus 19:37 Therefore shall ye observe all my statutes, and all my judgments, and do them: **I AM THE LORD.**
- Leviticus 20:7 Sanctify yourselves therefore, and be ye holy: for **I AM THE LORD** your God.
- Leviticus 20:8 And ye shall keep my statutes, and do them: **I AM THE LORD** which sanctify you.
- Leviticus 20:24 But I have said unto you, Ye shall inherit their land, and I will give it unto you to possess it, a land that floweth with milk and honey: **I AM THE LORD** your God, which have separated you from *other* people.
- Leviticus 21:12 Neither shall he go out of the sanctuary, nor profane the sanctuary of his God; for the crown of the anointing oil of his God *is* upon him: **I AM THE LORD.**
- Leviticus 22:2 Speak unto Aaron and to his sons, that they separate themselves from the holy things of the children of Israel, and that they profane not my holy name *in those things* which they hallow unto me: **I AM THE LORD.**
- Leviticus 22:3 Say unto them, Whosoever *he be* of all your seed among your generations, that goeth unto the holy things, which the children of Israel hallow unto the LORD, having his uncleanness upon him, that soul shall be cut off from my presence: **I AM THE LORD.**
- Leviticus 22:8 That which dieth of itself, or is torn *with beasts*, he shall not eat to defile himself therewith: **I AM THE LORD.**
- Leviticus 22:30 On the same day it shall be eaten up; ye shall leave none of it until the morrow: **I AM THE LORD.**
- Leviticus 22:31 Therefore shall ye keep my commandments, and do them: <u>I AM THE</u> <u>LORD.</u>
- Leviticus 22:32 Neither shall ye profane my holy name; but I will be hallowed among the children of Israel: **I AM THE LORD** which hallow you,
- Leviticus 22:33 That brought you out of the land of Egypt, to be your God: <u>I AM THE</u> <u>LORD.</u>
- Leviticus 23:22 And when ye reap the harvest of your land, thou shalt not make clean riddance of the corners of thy field when thou reapest, neither shalt thou gather any gleaning of thy harvest: thou shalt leave them unto the poor, and to the stranger: **I AM THE LORD** your God.
- Leviticus 23:43 That your generations may know that I made the children of Israel to dwell in booths, when I brought them out of the land of Egypt: **I AM THE LORD** your God.

Leviticus 24:22 Ye shall have one manner of law, as well for the stranger, as for one of your own country: for **I AM THE LORD** your God.

#### Isaiah = 12x

- Isaiah 42:8 **I AM THE LORD** that *is* my name: and my glory will I not give to another, neither my praise to graven images.
- Isaiah 43:3 For **I AM THE LORD** your God, the Holy One of Israel, thy Savior: I gave Egypt *for* your ransom, Ethiopia and Seba for you.
- Isaiah 43:11 I, even I, AM THE LORD; and beside me there is no savior.
- Isaiah 43:15 **I AM THE LORD** your Holy One, the creator of Israel, your King.
- Isaiah 44:24 Thus saith the LORD, thy redeemer, and he that formed thee from the womb, **I AM THE LORD** that makes all *things*; that stretches forth the heavens alone; that spreads abroad the earth by myself;
- Isaiah 45:5 **I AM THE LORD** and *there is* none else, *there is* no God beside me: I girded you, though you have not known me:
- Isaiah 45:6 That they may know from the rising of the sun, and from the west, that *there is* none beside me. **I AM THE LORD** and *there is* none else.
- Isaiah 45:18 For thus saith the LORD that created the heavens; God himself that formed the earth and made it; he hath established it, he created it not in vain, he formed it to be inhabited: **I** AM THE LORD; and there is none else.
- Isaiah 48:17 Thus saith the LORD, thy Redeemer, the Holy One of Israel; **I AM THE LORD** thy God which teacheth thee to profit, which leadeth thee by the way *that* thou shouldest go.
- Isaiah 49:23 And kings shall be thy nursing fathers, and their queens thy nursing mothers: they shall bow down to thee with *their* face toward the earth, and lick up the dust of thy feet; and thou shalt know that **I AM THE LORD** for they shall not be ashamed that wait for me.
- Isaiah 51:15 But <u>I AM THE LORD</u> thy God, that divided the sea, whose waves roared: The LORD of hosts *is* his name.

## Ezekiel = 67x (63x is "shall know that I am the LORD")

- Ezekiel 6:7 And the slain shall fall in the midst of you, and ye shall know that **I AM THE LORD.**
- Ezekiel 6:10 And they shall know that **I AM THE LORD** and that I have not said in vain that I would do this evil unto them.
- Ezekiel 6:13 Then shall ye know that **I AM THE LORD** when their slain *men* shall be among their idols round about their altars, upon every high hill, in all the tops of the mountains, and under every green tree, and under every thick oak, the place where they did offer sweet savour to all their idols.
- Ezekiel 6:14 So will I stretch out my hand upon them, and make the land desolate, yea, more desolate than the wilderness toward Diblath, in all their habitations: and they shall know that **I AM THE LORD.**
- Ezekiel 7:4 And mine eye shall not spare thee, neither will I have pity: but I will recompense thy ways upon thee, and thine abominations shall be in the midst of thee: and ye shall know that **I AM THE LORD**.
- Ezekiel 7:9 And mine eye shall not spare, neither will I have pity: I will recompense thee according to thy ways and thine abominations *that* are in the midst of thee; and ye shall know that **I AM THE LORD** that smiteth.
- Ezekiel 7:27 The king shall mourn, and the prince shall be clothed with desolation, and the hands of the people of the land shall be troubled: I will do unto them after their way, and according to their deserts will I judge them; and they shall know that <u>I AM</u> **THE LORD.**
- Ezekiel 11:10 Ye shall fall by the sword; I will judge you in the border of Israel; and ye shall know that **I AM THE LORD**.
- Ezekiel 11:12 And ye shall know that **I AM THE LORD** for ye have not walked in my statutes, neither executed my judgments, but have done after the manners of the heathen that *are* round about you.
- Ezekiel 12:15 And they shall know that **I AM THE LORD** when I shall scatter them among the nations, and disperse them in the countries.
- Ezekiel 12:16 But I will leave a few men of them from the sword, from the famine, and from the pestilence; that they may declare all their abominations among the heathen whither they come; and they shall know that <u>I AM THE LORD.</u>
- Ezekiel 12:20 And the cities that are inhabited shall be laid waste, and the land shall be desolate; and ye shall know that **I AM THE LORD.**
- Ezekiel 12:25 For <u>I AM THE LORD</u> I will speak, and the word that I shall speak shall come to pass; it shall be no more prolonged: for in your days, O rebellious house, will I say the word, and will perform it, saith the Lord GOD.
- Ezekiel 13:9 And mine hand shall be upon the prophets that see vanity, and that divine lies: they shall not be in the assembly of my people, neither shall they be written in the writing of the house of Israel, neither shall they enter into the land of Israel; and ye shall know that **I AM THE LORD** GOD.
- Ezekiel 13:14 So will I break down the wall that ye have daubed with untempered *morter*, and bring it down to the ground, so that the foundation thereof shall be discovered, and it shall fall, and ye shall be consumed in the midst thereof: and ye shall know that I AM THE LORD.

- Ezekiel 13:21 Your kerchiefs also will I tear, and deliver my people out of your hand, and they shall be no more in your hand to be hunted; and ye shall know that <u>I AM</u> <u>THE LORD.</u>
- Ezekiel 13:23 Therefore ye shall see no more vanity, nor divine divinations: for I will deliver my people out of your hand: and ye shall know that **I AM THE LORD.**
- Ezekiel 14:8 And I will set my face against that man, and will make him a sign and a proverb, and I will cut him off from the midst of my people; and ye shall know that **I AM THE LORD.**
- Ezekiel 15:7 And I will set my face against them; they shall go out from *one* fire, and *another* fire shall devour them; and ye shall know that <u>I AM THE LORD</u> when I set my face against them.
- Ezekiel 16:62 And I will establish my covenant with thee; and thou shalt know that <u>I</u> <u>AM THE LORD</u>
- Ezekiel 20:5 And say unto them, Thus saith the Lord GOD; In the day when I chose Israel, and lifted up mine hand unto the seed of the house of Jacob, and made myself known unto them in the land of Egypt, when I lifted up mine hand unto them, saying, **IAM THE LORD** your God;
- Ezekiel 20:7 Then said I unto them, Cast ye away every man the abominations of his eyes, and defile not yourselves with the idols of Egypt: **I AM THE LORD** your God.
- Ezekiel 20:12 Moreover also I gave them my sabbaths, to be a sign between me and them, that they might know that **I AM THE LORD** that sanctify them.
- Ezekiel 20:19 **I AM THE LORD** your God; walk in my statutes, and keep my judgments, and do them;
- Ezekiel 20:20 And hallow my sabbaths; and they shall be a sign between me and you, that ye may know that I AM THE LORD your God.
- Ezekiel 20:26 And I polluted them in their own gifts, in that they caused to pass through *the fire* all that openeth the womb, that I might make them desolate, to the end that they might know that I AM THE LORD.
- Ezekiel 20:38 And I will purge out from among you the rebels, and them that transgress against me: I will bring them forth out of the country where they sojourn, and they shall not enter into the land of Israel: and ye shall know that <u>I AM THE LORD.</u>
- Ezekiel 20:42 And ye shall know that <u>I AM THE LORD</u> when I shall bring you into the land of Israel, into the country *for* the which I lifted up mine hand to give it to your fathers.
- Ezekiel 20:44 And ye shall know that **I AM THE LORD** when I have wrought with you for my name's sake, not according to your wicked ways, nor according to your corrupt doings, O ye house of Israel, saith the Lord GOD.
- Ezekiel 22:16 And thou shalt take thine inheritance in thyself in the sight of the heathen, and thou shalt know that **I AM THE LORD**.
- Ezekiel 23:49 And they shall recompense your lewdness upon you, and ye shall bear the sins of your idols: and ye shall know that **I AM THE LORD** GOD.
- Ezekiel 24:24 Thus Ezekiel is unto you a sign: according to all that he hath done shall ye do: and when this cometh, ye shall know that **I AM THE LORD** GOD.
- Ezekiel 24:27 In that day shall thy mouth be opened to him which is escaped, and thou shalt speak, and be no more dumb: and thou shalt be a sign unto them; and they shall know that **I AM THE LORD.**

- Ezekiel 25:5 And I will make Rabbah a stable for camels, and the Ammonites a couchingplace for flocks: and ye shall know that **I AM THE LORD.**
- Ezekiel 25:7 Behold, therefore I will stretch out mine hand upon thee, and will deliver thee for a spoil to the heathen; and I will cut thee off from the people, and I will cause thee to perish out of the countries: I will destroy thee; and thou shalt know that <u>I AM</u> **THE LORD.**
- Ezekiel 25:11 And I will execute judgments upon Moab; and they shall know that <u>I AM</u> **THE LORD.**
- Ezekiel 25:17 And I will execute great vengeance upon them with furious rebukes; and they shall know that **I AM THE LORD** when I shall lay my vengeance upon them.
- Ezekiel 26:6 And her daughters which *are* in the field shall be slain by the sword; and they shall know that **I AM THE LORD.**
- Ezekiel 28:22 And say, Thus saith the Lord GOD; Behold, I *am* against thee, O Zidon; and I will be glorified in the midst of thee: and they shall know that <u>I AM THE</u> LORD when I shall have executed judgments in her, and shall be sanctified in her.
- Ezekiel 28:23 For I will send into her pestilence, and blood into her streets; and the wounded shall be judged in the midst of her by the sword upon her on every side; and they shall know that **I AM THE LORD.**
- Ezekiel 28:24 And there shall be no more a pricking brier unto the house of Israel, nor *any* grieving thorn of all *that are* round about them, that despised them; and they shall know that **I AM THE LORD** GOD.
- Ezekiel 28:26 And they shall dwell safely therein, and shall build houses, and plant vineyards; yea, they shall dwell with confidence, when I have executed judgments upon all those that despise them round about them; and they shall know that <u>I AM THE LORD</u> their God.
- Ezekiel 29:6 And all the inhabitants of Egypt shall know that <u>I AM THE LORD</u> because they have been a staff of reed to the house of Israel.
- Ezekiel 29:9 And the land of Egypt shall be desolate and waste; and they shall know that **IAM THE LORD** because he hath said, The river *is* mine, and I have made *it*.
- Ezekiel 29:16 And it shall be no more the confidence of the house of Israel, which bringeth *their* iniquity to remembrance, when they shall look after them: but they shall know that **IAM THE LORD** GOD.
- Ezekiel 29:21 In that day will I cause the horn of the house of Israel to bud forth, and I will give thee the opening of the mouth in the midst of them; and they shall know that I AM THE LORD.
- Ezekiel 30:8 And they shall know that **I AM THE LORD** when I have set a fire in Egypt, and *when* all her helpers shall be destroyed.
- Ezekiel 30:19 Thus will I execute judgments in Egypt: and they shall know that <u>I AM</u> <u>THE LORD.</u>
- Ezekiel 30:25 But I will strengthen the arms of the king of Babylon, and the arms of Pharaoh shall fall down; and they shall know that **I AM THE LORD** when I shall put my sword into the hand of the king of Babylon, and he shall stretch it out upon the land of Egypt.
- Ezekiel 30:26 And I will scatter the Egyptians among the nations, and disperse them among the countries; and they shall know that <u>I AM THE LORD.</u>

- Ezekiel 32:15 When I shall make the land of Egypt desolate, and the country shall be destitute of that whereof it was full, when I shall smite all them that dwell therein, then shall they know that **I AM THE LORD.**
- Ezekiel 33:29 Then shall they know that **I AM THE LORD** when I have laid the land most desolate because of all their abominations which they have committed.
- Ezekiel 34:27 And the tree of the field shall yield her fruit, and the earth shall yield her increase, and they shall be safe in their land, and shall know that **I AM THE LORD** when I have broken the bands of their yoke, and delivered them out of the hand of those that served themselves of them.
- Ezekiel 35:4 I will lay thy cities waste, and thou shalt be desolate, and thou shalt know that I AM THE LORD.
- Ezekiel 35:9 I will make thee perpetual desolations, and thy cities shall not return: and ye shall know that <u>I AM THE LORD.</u>
- Ezekiel 35:12 And thou shalt know that <u>I AM THE LORD</u> and that I have heard all thy blasphemies which thou hast spoken against the mountains of Israel, saying, They are laid desolate, they are given us to consume.
- Ezekiel 35:15 As thou didst rejoice at the inheritance of the house of Israel, because it was desolate, so will I do unto thee: thou shalt be desolate, O mount Seir, and all Idumea, *even* all of it: and they shall know that **I AM THE LORD.**
- Ezekiel 36:11 And I will multiply upon you man and beast; and they shall increase and bring fruit: and I will settle you after your old estates, and will do better *unto you* than at your beginnings: and ye shall know that **I AM THE LORD.**
- Ezekiel 36:23 And I will sanctify my great name, which was profaned among the heathen, which ye have profaned in the midst of them; and the heathen shall know that **I AM THE LORD** saith the Lord GOD, when I shall be sanctified in you before their eyes.
- Ezekiel 36:38 As the holy flock, as the flock of Jerusalem in her solemn feasts; so shall the waste cities be filled with flocks of men: and they shall know that <u>I AM THE</u> <u>LORD.</u>
- Ezekiel 37:6 And I will lay sinews upon you, and will bring up flesh upon you, and cover you with skin, and put breath in you, and ye shall live; and ye shall know that **I AM THE LORD.**
- Ezekiel 37:13 And ye shall know that **I AM THE LORD** when I have opened your graves, O my people, and brought you up out of your graves,
- Ezekiel 38:23 Thus will I magnify myself, and sanctify myself; and I will be known in the eyes of many nations, and they shall know that <u>I AM THE LORD.</u>
- Ezekiel 39:6 And I will send a fire on Magog, and among them that dwell carelessly in the isles: and they shall know that <u>I AM THE LORD.</u>
- Ezekiel 39:7 So will I make my holy name known in the midst of my people Israel; and I will not *let them* pollute my holy name any more: and the heathen shall know that <u>I</u> <u>AM THE LORD</u> the Holy One in Israel.
- Ezekiel 39:22 So the house of Israel shall know that <u>I AM THE LORD</u> their God from that day and forward.
- Ezekiel 39:28 Then shall they know that <u>I AM THE LORD</u> their God, which caused them to be led into captivity among the heathen: but I have gathered them unto their own land, and have left none of them any more there.
