Lesson 2 – Jonah's Call & Mission

Jonah Chapter One

I Now the word of the LORD came unto <u>Jonah the son of Amittai</u>, saying, 2 <u>Arise</u>, go to <u>Nineveh</u>, that <u>great city</u>, and cry against it; for their wickedness is come up before me. 3 <u>But Jonah rose up to flee unto Tarshish</u> from the presence of the LORD, and went down to Joppa; and he found a ship going to Tarshish: so he paid the fare thereof, and went down into it, to go with them unto Tarshish from the presence of the LORD. 4 <u>But the LORD</u> sent out a great wind into the sea, and there was a mighty tempest in the sea, so that the ship was like to be broken.

- Who was <u>Jonah</u>? "Jonah the son of Amittai"
- What and Where was <u>Nineveh</u>? "Nineveh, that great city
- What and Where was <u>Tarshish</u>? "flee to Tarshish" to Southern Spain, Gibraltar
- Who were the <u>sailors</u> and What happened to them?

Other Reluctant Prophets

It is not unusual for prophets to feel unworthy for the task. But with Jonah it was not <u>unworthiness</u> but <u>unwillingness</u>.

- Jeremiah Jeremiah 1:6 "I said, Ah, Lord GOD! Behold, I cannot speak: for I am a child."
- Peter John 21:21 "Peter seeing him said to Jesus, Lord, and what shall this man do?"
