Discussion Starters

- 1. Were you every so angry with your parents that you ran away from home, or wanted to run away from home? Why? What angered you?
- 2. Did you ever get in trouble for disobeying your parents? How bad were you? What did you do? What were the consequences?
- 3. Have any of your children excelled in being disobedient and contrary? What did they not do? How did you discipline them?
- 4. What were the punishments, or disciplines your parents exercised on you? And what discipline or punishments did you use on your children?

Hebrews 12:6-11 For whom the Lord loves he chastens, and scourges every son whom he receives. 7 If you endure chastening, God deals with you as with sons; for what son is he whom the father does not chasten? 8 But if you were without chastisement, whereof all are partakers, then you would be bastards, and not sons. 9 Furthermore we have had fathers of our flesh which corrected us, and we gave them reverence: shall we not much rather be in subjection unto the Father of spirits, and live? 10 For they verily for a few days chastened us after their own pleasure; but he for our profit, that we might be partakers of his holiness. 11 Now no chastening for the present seems to be joyous, but grievous: nevertheless afterward it yields the peaceable fruit of righteousness unto them which are exercised thereby.
