"Tarshish"

- Genesis 10:4 And the sons of Javan; Elishah, and Tarshish, Kittim, and Dodanim.
- 1 Chronicles 1:7 And the sons of Javan; Elishah, and Tarshish, Kittim, and Dodanim.
- 2 Chronicles 9:21 For the king's ships went to <u>Tarshish</u> with the servants of Huram: every three years once came the ships of <u>Tarshish</u> bringing gold, and silver, ivory, and apes, and peacocks.
- 2 Chronicles 20:36 And he joined himself with him to make ships to go to <u>Tarshish</u>: and they made the ships in Eziongeber.
- 2 Chronicles 20:37 Then Eliezer the son of Dodavah of Mareshah prophesied against Jehoshaphat, saying, Because thou hast joined thyself with Ahaziah, the LORD hath broken thy works. And the ships were broken, that they were not able to go to <u>Tarshish</u>.
- Esther 1:14 And the next unto him *was* Carshena, Shethar, Admatha, <u>Tarshish</u>, Meres, Marsena, *and* Memucan, the seven princes of Persia and Media, which saw the king's face, *and* which sat the first in the kingdom;)
- Psalms 48:7 Thou breakest the ships of <u>Tarshish</u> with an east wind.
- Psalms 72:10 The kings of <u>Tarshish</u> and of the isles shall bring presents: the kings of Sheba and Seba shall offer gifts.
- Isaiah 2:16 And upon all the ships of <u>Tarshish</u>, and upon all pleasant pictures.
- Isaiah 23:1 ¶ The burden of Tyre. Howl, ye ships of <u>Tarshish</u>; for it is laid waste, so that there is no house, no entering in: from the land of Chittim it is revealed to them.
- Isaiah 23:6 Pass ye over to <u>Tarshish</u>; howl, ye inhabitants of the isle.
- Isaiah 23:10 Pass through thy land as a river, O daughter of <u>Tarshish</u>: *there is* no more strength.
- Isaiah 23:14 Howl, ye ships of <u>Tarshish</u>: for your strength is laid waste.
- Isaiah 60:9 ¶ Surely the isles shall wait for me, and the ships of <u>Tarshish</u> first, to bring thy sons from far, their silver and their gold with them, unto the name of the LORD thy God, and to the Holy One of Israel, because he hath glorified thee.
- Isaiah 66:19 And I will set a sign among them, and I will send those that escape of them unto the nations, *to* <u>Tarshish</u>, Pul, and Lud, that draw the bow, *to* Tubal, and Javan, *to* the isles afar off, that have not heard my fame, neither have seen my glory; and they shall declare my glory among the Gentiles.
- Jeremiah 10:9 Silver spread into plates is brought from <u>Tarshish</u>, and gold from Uphaz, the work of the workman, and of the hands of the founder: blue and purple *is* their clothing: they *are* all the work of cunning *men*.
- Ezekiel 27:12 <u>Tarshish</u> was thy merchant by reason of the multitude of all kind of riches; with silver, iron, tin, and lead, they traded in thy fairs.
- Ezekiel 27:25 The ships of <u>Tarshish</u> did sing of thee in thy market: and thou wast replenished, and made very glorious in the midst of the seas.
- Ezekiel 38:13 Sheba, and Dedan, and the merchants of <u>Tarshish</u>, with all the young lions thereof, shall say unto thee, Art thou come to take a spoil? hast thou gathered thy company to take a prey? to carry away silver and gold, to take away cattle and goods, to take a great spoil?

Jonah 1:3 But Jonah rose up to flee unto <u>Tarshish</u> from the presence of the LORD, and went down to Joppa; and he found a ship going to <u>Tarshish</u>: so he paid the fare thereof, and went down into it, to go with them unto <u>Tarshish</u> from the presence of the LORD. Jonah 4:2 And he prayed unto the LORD, and said, I pray thee, O LORD, *was* not this my saying, when I was yet in my country? Therefore I fled before unto <u>Tarshish</u>: for I knew that thou *art* a gracious God, and merciful, slow to anger, and of great kindness, and repentest thee of the evil.
