- Deuteronomy 32:22 For a fire is kindled in mine anger, and shall burn unto the lowest <u>hell</u>, and shall consume the earth with her increase, and set on fire the foundations of the mountains.
- 2 Samuel 22:6 The sorrows of <u>hell</u> compassed me about; the snares of death prevented me;
- Job 11:8 It is as high as heaven; what canst thou do? deeper than hell; what canst thou know?
- Job 26:6 Hell is naked before him, and destruction hath no covering.
- Psalms 9:17 The wicked shall be turned into <u>hell</u>, and all the nations that forget God.
- Psalms 16:10 For thou wilt not leave my soul in <u>hell</u>; neither wilt thou suffer thine Holy One to see corruption.
- Psalms 18:5 The sorrows of <u>hell</u> compassed me about: the snares of death prevented me.
- Psalms 55:15 Let death seize upon them, *and* let them go down quick into <u>hell</u>: for wickedness *is* in their dwellings, *and* among them.
- Psalms 86:13 For great is thy mercy toward me: and thou hast delivered my soul from the lowest hell.
- Psalms 116:3 The sorrows of death compassed me, and the pains of <u>hell</u> gat hold upon me: I found trouble and sorrow.
- Psalms 139:8 If I ascend up into heaven, thou *art* there: if I make my bed in <u>hell</u>, behold, thou *art there*.
- Proverbs 5:5 Her feet go down to death; her steps take hold on hell.
- Proverbs 7:27 Her house is the way to hell, going down to the chambers of death.
- Proverbs 9:18 But he knoweth not that the dead are there; and that her guests are in the depths of hell.
- Proverbs 15:11 <u>Hell</u> and destruction *are* before the LORD: how much more then the hearts of the children of men?
- Proverbs 15:24 The way of life *is* above to the wise, that he may depart from <u>hell</u> beneath.
- Proverbs 23:14 Thou shalt beat him with the rod, and shalt deliver his soul from hell.
- Proverbs 27:20 Hell and destruction are never full; so the eyes of man are never satisfied.
- Isaiah 5:14 Therefore <u>hell</u> hath enlarged herself, and opened her mouth without measure: and their glory, and their multitude, and their pomp, and he that rejoiceth, shall descend into it.
- Isaiah 14:9 <u>Hell</u> from beneath is moved for thee to meet *thee* at thy coming: it stirreth up the dead for thee, *even* all the chief ones of the earth; it hath raised up from their thrones all the kings of the nations.
- Isaiah 14:15 Yet thou shalt be brought down to <u>hell</u>, to the sides of the pit.
- Isaiah 28:15 Because ye have said, We have made a covenant with death, and with <u>hell</u> are we at agreement; when the overflowing scourge shall pass through, it shall not come unto us: for we have made lies our refuge, and under falsehood have we hid ourselves:
- Isaiah 28:18 And your covenant with death shall be disannulled, and your agreement with <u>hell</u> shall not stand; when the overflowing scourge shall pass through, then ye shall be trodden down by it.
- Isaiah 57:9 And thou wentest to the king with ointment, and didst increase thy perfumes, and didst send thy messengers far off, and didst debase *thyself even* unto <u>hell</u>.

- Ezekiel 31:16 I made the nations to shake at the sound of his fall, when I cast him down to <u>hell</u> with them that descend into the pit: and all the trees of Eden, the choice and best of Lebanon, all that drink water, shall be comforted in the nether parts of the earth.
- Ezekiel 31:17 They also went down into <u>hell</u> with him unto *them that be* slain with the sword; and *they that were* his arm, *that* dwelt under his shadow in the midst of the heathen.
- Ezekiel 32:21 The strong among the mighty shall speak to him out of the midst of <u>hell</u> with them that help him: they are gone down, they lie uncircumcised, slain by the sword.
- Ezekiel 32:27 And they shall not lie with the mighty *that are* fallen of the uncircumcised, which are gone down to <u>hell</u> with their weapons of war: and they have laid their swords under their heads, but their iniquities shall be upon their bones, though *they were* the terror of the mighty in the land of the living.
- Amos 9:2 Though they dig into <u>hell</u>, thence shall mine hand take them; though they climb up to heaven, thence will I bring them down:
- Jonah 2:2 And said, I cried by reason of mine affliction unto the LORD, and he heard me; out of the belly of <u>hell</u> cried I, *and* thou heardest my voice.
- Habakkuk 2:5 Yea also, because he transgresseth by wine, *he is* a proud man, neither keepeth at home, who enlargeth his desire as <u>hell</u>, and *is* as death, and cannot be satisfied, but gathereth unto him all nations, and heapeth unto him all people:

New Testament Greek: HELL

<u>Gehenna</u> - 1067 γεεννα geenna *gheh'-en-nah* of Hebrew origin קיא-הנם, 01516 and 02011; AV-hell 9, hell fire+3588 +4442 3; 12

Hades 86 Aδης hades hah'-dace from 1 (as negative particle) and 1492; n

- 1) name Hades or Pluto, the god of the lower regions
- 2) Orcus, the nether world, the realm of the dead
- 3) later use of this word: the grave, death, hell

In Biblical Greek it is associated with Orcus, the infernal regions, a dark and dismal place in the very depths of the earth, the common receptacle of disembodied spirits. Usually Hades is just the abode of the wicked, #Lu 16:23; Re 20:13,14; a very uncomfortable place.

Tartaros 5020 ταρταροω tartaroo *tar-tar-o'-o* from Tartaros (the deepest abyss of Hell); ;v AV-hell 10, grave 1; 11

- 1) the name of the subterranean region, doleful and dark, regarded by the ancient Greeks as the abode of the wicked dead, where they suffer punishment for their evil deeds; it answers to Gehenna of the Jews
- 2) to thrust down to Tartarus, to hold captive in Tartarus
- 1) Hell is the place of the future punishment call "Gehenna" or "Gehenna of fire". This was originally the valley of Hinnom, south of Jerusalem, where the filth and dead animals of the city were cast out and burned; a fit symbol of the wicked and their future destruction.

<u>Gehenna</u> - 1067 γεεννα geenna gheh'-en-nah of Hebrew origin קיא-הנם,

- Matthew 5:22 But I say unto you, That whosoever is angry with his brother without a cause shall be in danger of the judgment: and whosoever shall say to his brother, Raca, shall be in danger of the council: but whosoever shall say, Thou fool, shall be in danger of hell <<u>1067></u> fire.
- Matthew 5:29 And if thy right eye offend thee, pluck it out, and cast *it* from thee: for it is profitable for thee that one of thy members should perish, and not *that* thy whole body should be cast into hell $\leq 1067 \geq$.
- Matthew 5:30 And if thy right hand offend thee, cut it off, and cast *it* from thee: for it is profitable for thee that one of thy members should perish, and not *that* thy whole body should be cast into hell $\leq 1067 \geq$.
- Matthew 10:28 And fear not them which kill the body, but are not able to kill the soul: but rather fear him which is able to destroy both soul and body in hell $\leq 1067 \geq$.
- Matthew 18:9 And if thine eye offend thee, pluck it out, and cast *it* from thee: it is better for thee to enter into life with one eye, rather than having two eyes to be cast into hell $\leq 1067 \geq$ fire.
- Matthew 23:15 Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye compass sea and land to make one proselyte, and when he is made, ye make him twofold more the child of hell <<u>1067></u> than yourselves.
- Matthew 23:33 Ye serpents, ye generation of vipers, how can ye escape the damnation of hell $\leq 1067 \geq ?$
- Mark 9:43 And if thy hand offend thee, cut it off: it is better for thee to enter into life maimed, than having two hands to go into hell $\leq 1067 \geq$, into the fire that never shall be quenched:
- Mark 9:45 And if thy foot offend thee, cut it off: it is better for thee to enter halt into life, than having two feet to be cast into hell $\leq 1067 \geq$, into the fire that never shall be quenched:
- Mark 9:47 And if thine eye offend thee, pluck it out: it is better for thee to enter into the kingdom of God with one eye, than having two eyes to be cast into hell $\leq 1067 \geq$ fire:
- Luke 12:5 But I will forewarn you whom ye shall fear: Fear him, which after he hath killed hath power to cast into hell $\leq 1067 \geq$; yea, I say unto you, Fear him.

James 3:6 And the tongue *is* a fire, a world of iniquity: so is the tongue among our members, that it defileth the whole body, and setteth on fire the course of nature; and it is set on fire of hell $\leq 1067 \geq$.

Hades 86 Αδης hades hah'-dace

- Matthew 11:23 And thou, Capernaum, which art exalted unto heaven, shalt be brought down to hell $\leq 86 \geq$: for if the mighty works, which have been done in thee, had been done in Sodom, it would have remained until this day.
- Matthew 16:18 And I say also unto thee, That thou art Peter, and upon this rock I will build my church; and the gates of hell $\leq 86 \geq$ shall not prevail against it.
- Luke 10:15 And thou, Capernaum, which art exalted to heaven, shalt be thrust down to hell <86>.
- Luke 16:23 And in hell <u><86></u> he lift up his eyes, being in torments, and seeth Abraham afar off, and Lazarus in his bosom.
- Acts 2:27 Because thou wilt not leave my soul in hell <u><86></u>, neither wilt thou suffer thine Holy One to see corruption.
- Acts 2:31 He seeing this before spake of the resurrection of Christ, that his soul was not left in hell <u><86></u>, neither his flesh did see corruption.

- Revelation 1:18 I *am* he that liveth, and was dead; and, behold, I am alive for evermore, Amen; and have the keys of hell $\leq 86 \geq$ and of death.
- Revelation 6:8 And I looked, and behold a pale horse: and his name that sat on him was Death, and Hell <u><86></u> followed with him. And power was given unto them over the fourth part of the earth, to kill with sword, and with hunger, and with death, and with the beasts of the earth.
