Word Study

"Assyrians"

- 2 Kings 19:35 And it came to pass that night, that the angel of the LORD went out, and smote in the camp of **the <u>Assyrians</u> an hundred fourscore and five thousand** (185,000): and when they arose early in the morning, behold, they *were* all dead corpses.
- Isaiah 19:23 In that day shall there be a **highway out of Egypt to Assyria**, and the **Assyrian shall come into Egypt**, and the **Egyptian into Assyria**, and the Egyptians shall **serve with the Assyrians**.
- Isaiah 37:36 Then the angel of the LORD went forth, and smote in the **camp of the**Assyrians a hundred and fourscore and five thousand (185,000): and when they arose early in the morning, behold, they were all dead corpses.
- Lamentations 5:6 We have given the hand *to* the Egyptians, *and to* the <u>Assyrians</u>, to be satisfied with bread.
- Ezekiel 16:28 Thou hast played the whore also with the <u>Assyrians</u>, because thou wast unsatiable; yea, thou hast played the harlot with them, and yet couldest not be satisfied.
- Ezekiel 23:5 And Aholah played the harlot when she was mine; and she doted on her lovers, on the <u>Assyrians</u> *her* neighbours,
- Ezekiel 23:9 Wherefore I have delivered her into the hand of her lovers, into the hand of the <u>Assyrians</u>, upon whom she doted.
- Ezekiel 23:12 She doted upon the <u>Assyrians</u> *her* neighbours, captains and rulers clothed most gorgeously, horsemen riding upon horses, all of them desirable young men.
- Ezekiel 23:23 The Babylonians, and all the Chaldeans, Pekod, and Shoa, and Koa, *and* all the <u>Assyrians</u> with them: all of them desirable young men, captains and rulers, great lords and renowned, all of them riding upon horses.
- Hosea 12:1 Ephraim feedeth on wind, and followeth after the east wind: he daily increaseth lies and desolation; and they do make a covenant with the <u>Assyrians</u>, and oil is carried into Egypt.

Assyria

- Genesis 2:14 And the name of the third river *is* Hiddekel: that *is* it which goeth toward the **east of** Assyria. And the fourth river *is* Euphrates.
- Genesis 25:18 And they dwelt from Havilah unto Shur, that *is* before Egypt, as thou goest **toward** <u>Assyria</u>: *and* he died in the presence of all his brethren.
- 2 Kings 15:19 *And* **Pul the king of** <u>Assyria</u> came against the land: and Menahem gave Pul a thousand talents of silver, that his hand might be with him to confirm the kingdom in his hand.
- 2 Kings 15:20 And Menahem exacted the money of Israel, *even* of all the mighty men of wealth, of each man fifty shekels of silver, to give to the **king of Assyria**. **So the king of Assyria** turned back, and stayed not there in the land.

- 2 Kings 15:29 In the days of Pekah king of Israel came <u>Tiglathpileser king of Assyria</u>, and took Ijon, and Abelbethmaachah, and Janoah, and Kedesh, and Hazor, and Gilead, and Galilee, all the land of Naphtali, and carried them captive to <u>Assyria</u>.
- 2 Kings 16:7 So Ahaz sent messengers to <u>Tiglathpileser king of Assyria</u>, saying, I *am* thy servant and thy son: come up, and save me out of the hand of the king of Syria, and out of the hand of the king of Israel, which rise up against me.
- 2 Kings 16:8 And Ahaz took the silver and gold that was found in the house of the LORD, and in the treasures of the king's house, and sent it for a present to the king of Assyria.
- 2 Kings 16:9 And the king of <u>Assyria</u> hearkened unto him: for the king of <u>Assyria</u> went up against Damascus, and took it, and carried *the people of* it captive to Kir, and slew Rezin.
- 2 Kings 16:10 And king Ahaz went to Damascus to meet <u>Tiglathpileser king of Assyria</u>, and saw an altar that *was* at Damascus: and king Ahaz sent to Urijah the priest the fashion of the altar, and the pattern of it, according to all the workmanship thereof.
- 2 Kings 16:18 And the covert for the sabbath that they had built in the house, and the king's entry without, turned he from the house of the LORD for the king of <u>Assyria</u>.
- 2 Kings 17:3 Against him came up **Shalmaneser king of <u>Assyria</u>**; and Hoshea became his servant, and gave him presents.
- 2 Kings 17:4 And the king of <u>Assyria</u> found conspiracy in Hoshea: for he had sent messengers to So king of Egypt, and brought no present to **the king of <u>Assyria</u>**, as *he had done* year by year: therefore **the king of <u>Assyria</u>** shut him up, and bound him in prison.
- 2 Kings 17:5 Then **the king of <u>Assyria</u>** came up throughout all the land, and went up to Samaria, and besieged it three years.
- 2 Kings 17:6 In the ninth year of Hoshea the king of Assyria took Samaria, and carried Israel away into Assyria, and placed them in Halah and in Habor by the river of Gozan, and in the cities of the Medes.
- 2 Kings 17:23 Until the LORD removed Israel out of his sight, as he had said by all his servants the prophets. So was Israel carried away out of their own land to <u>Assyria</u> unto this day.
- 2 Kings 17:24 And the king of <u>Assyria</u> brought *men* from Babylon, and from Cuthah, and from Ava, and from Hamath, and from Sepharvaim, and placed *them* in the cities of Samaria instead of the children of Israel: and they possessed Samaria, and dwelt in the cities thereof.
- 2 Kings 17:26 Wherefore they spake to **the king of Assyria**, saying, The nations which thou hast removed, and placed in the cities of Samaria, know not the manner of the God of the land: therefore he hath sent lions among them, and, behold, they slay them, because they know not the manner of the God of the land.
- 2 Kings 17:27 Then the king of <u>Assyria</u> commanded, saying, Carry thither one of the priests whom ye brought from thence; and let them go and dwell there, and let him teach them the manner of the God of the land.
- 2 Kings 18:7 And the LORD was with him; *and* he prospered whithersoever he went forth: and **he rebelled against the king of <u>Assyria</u>**, and served him not.
- 2 Kings 18:9 And it came to pass in the fourth year of king Hezekiah, which was the seventh year of Hoshea son of Elah king of Israel, that **Shalmaneser king of Assyria** came up against Samaria, and besieged it.

- 2 Kings 18:11 And the **king of <u>Assyria</u> did carry away Israel unto <u>Assyria</u>, and put them in Halah and in Habor by the river of Gozan, and in the cities of the Medes:**
- 2 Kings 18:13 Now in the fourteenth year of king Hezekiah did **Sennacherib king of**Assyria come up against all the fenced cities of Judah, and took them.
- 2 Kings 18:14 And Hezekiah king of Judah sent to **the king of Assyria** to Lachish, saying, I have offended; return from me: that which thou puttest on me will I bear. And **the king of Assyria** appointed unto Hezekiah king of Judah three hundred talents of silver and thirty talents of gold.
- 2 Kings 18:16 At that time did Hezekiah cut off *the gold from* the doors of the temple of the LORD, and *from* the pillars which Hezekiah king of Judah had overlaid, and **gave it to the king of Assyria.**
- 2 Kings 18:17 And **the king of <u>Assyria</u>** sent Tartan and Rabsaris and Rabshakeh from Lachish to king Hezekiah with a great host against Jerusalem. And they went up and came to Jerusalem. And when they were come up, they came and stood by the conduit of the upper pool, which *is* in the highway of the fuller's field.
- 2 Kings 18:19 And Rabshakeh said unto them, Speak ye now to Hezekiah, Thus saith the great king, **the king of** <u>Assyria</u>, What confidence *is* this wherein thou trustest?
- 2 Kings 18:23 Now therefore, I pray thee, give pledges to my lord **the king of Assyria**, and I will deliver thee two thousand horses, if thou be able on thy part to set riders upon them.
- 2 Kings 18:28 Then Rabshakeh stood and cried with a loud voice in the Jews' language, and spake, saying, **Hear the word of the great king, the king of Assyria:**
- 2 Kings 18:30 Neither let Hezekiah make you trust in the LORD, saying, **The LORD will** surely deliver us, and this city shall not be delivered into the hand of the king of Assyria.
- 2 Kings 18:31 Hearken not to Hezekiah: for thus saith the **king of Assyria**, Make *an agreement* with me by a present, and come out to me, and *then* eat ye every man of his own vine, and every one of his fig tree, and drink ye every one the waters of his cistern:
- 2 Kings 18:33 Hath any of the gods of the nations delivered at all his land out of the hand of **the king of** <u>Assyria</u>?
- 2 Kings 19:4 It may be the LORD thy God will hear all the words of Rabshakeh, whom **the king of Assyria** his master hath sent to reproach the living God; and will reprove the words which the LORD thy God hath heard: wherefore lift up *thy* prayer for the remnant that are left.
- 2 Kings 19:6 And Isaiah said unto them, Thus shall ye say to your master, Thus saith the LORD, Be not afraid of the words which thou hast heard, with which the servants of the king of Assyria have blasphemed me.
- 2 Kings 19:8 So Rabshakeh returned, and found **the king of Assyria** warring against Libnah: for he had heard that he was departed from Lachish.
- 2 Kings 19:10 Thus shall ye speak to Hezekiah king of Judah, saying, Let not thy God in whom thou trustest deceive thee, saying, Jerusalem shall not be delivered into the hand of **the king of Assyria.**
- 2 Kings 19:11 Behold, thou hast heard what **the kings of Assyria** have done to all lands, by destroying them utterly: and shalt thou be delivered?
- 2 Kings 19:17 Of a truth, LORD, **the kings of Assyria** have destroyed the nations and their lands,

- 2 Kings 19:20 Then Isaiah the son of Amoz sent to Hezekiah, saying, Thus saith the LORD God of Israel, *That* which thou hast prayed to me against **Sennacherib king of <u>Assyria</u>** I have heard.
- 2 Kings 19:32 Therefore thus saith the LORD concerning **the king of Assyria**, He shall not come into this city, nor shoot an arrow there, nor come before it with shield, nor cast a bank against it.
- 2 Kings 19:36 So Sennacherib king of <u>Assyria</u> departed, and went and returned, and dwelt at Nineveh.
- 2 Kings 20:6 And I will add unto thy days fifteen years; and I will deliver thee and this city out of the hand of **the king of Assyria**; and I will defend this city for mine own sake, and for my servant David's sake.
- 2 Kings 23:29 In his days Pharaohnechoh king of Egypt went up against **the king of**<u>Assyria</u> to the river Euphrates: and king Josiah went against him; and he slew him at Megiddo, when he had seen him.
- 1 Chronicles 5:6 Beerah his son, whom **Tilgathpilneser king of Assyria** carried away *captive*: he *was* prince of the Reubenites.
- 1 Chronicles 5:26 And the God of Israel stirred up the spirit of **Pul king of Assyria**, and the spirit of **Tilgathpilneser king of Assyria**, and he carried them away, even the Reubenites, and the Gadites, and the half tribe of Manasseh, and brought them unto Halah, and Habor, and Hara, and to the river Gozan, unto this day.
- 2 Chronicles 28:16 ¶ At that time did king **Ahaz send unto the kings of <u>Assyria</u>** to help him.
- 2 Chronicles 28:20 And **Tilgathpilneser king of <u>Assyria</u>** came unto him, and distressed him, but strengthened him not.
- 2 Chronicles 28:21 For Ahaz took away a portion *out* of the house of the LORD, and *out* of the house of the king, and of the princes, and gave *it* unto **the king of Assyria**: but he helped him not.
- 2 Chronicles 30:6 So the posts went with the letters from the king and his princes throughout all Israel and Judah, and according to the commandment of the king, saying, Ye children of Israel, turn again unto the LORD God of Abraham, Isaac, and Israel, and he will return to the remnant of you, that are escaped out of the hand of the kings of Assyria.
- 2 Chronicles 32:1 After these things, and the establishment thereof, **Sennacherib king of**<u>Assyria</u> came, and entered into Judah, and encamped against the fenced cities, and thought to win them for himself.
- 2 Chronicles 32:4 So there was gathered much people together, who stopped all the fountains, and the brook that ran through the midst of the land, saying, Why should **the kings of** <u>Assyria</u> come, and find much water?
- 2 Chronicles 32:7 Be strong and courageous, be not afraid nor dismayed for **the king of**Assyria, nor for all the multitude that is with him: for there be more with us than with him:
- 2 Chronicles 32:9 After this **did Sennacherib king of Assyria** send his servants to Jerusalem, (but he *himself laid siege* against Lachish, and all his power with him,) unto Hezekiah king of Judah, and unto all Judah that *were* at Jerusalem, saying,
- 2 Chronicles 32:10 Thus saith **Sennacherib king of <u>Assyria</u>**, Whereon do ye trust, that ye abide in the siege in Jerusalem?

- 2 Chronicles 32:11 Doth not Hezekiah persuade you to give over yourselves to die by famine and by thirst, saying, **The LORD our God shall deliver us out of the hand of the king of Assyria?**
- 2 Chronicles 32:21 And the LORD sent an angel, which cut off all the mighty men of valour, and the leaders and captains in the camp of **the king of Assyria.** So he returned with shame of face to his own land. And when he was come into the house of his god, they that came forth of his own bowels slew him there with the sword.
- 2 Chronicles 32:22 Thus the LORD saved Hezekiah and the inhabitants of Jerusalem from the hand of **Sennacherib the king of Assyria**, and from the hand of all *other*, and guided them on every side.
- 2 Chronicles 33:11 Wherefore the LORD brought upon them the captains of the host of the **king of Assyria**, which took Manasseh among the thorns, and bound him with fetters, and carried him to Babylon.
- Ezra 6:22 And kept the feast of unleavened bread seven days with joy: for the LORD had made them joyful, and turned the heart of **the king of Assyria** unto them, to strengthen their hands in the work of the house of God, the God of Israel.
- Nehemiah 9:32 Now therefore, our God, the great, the mighty, and the terrible God, who keepest covenant and mercy, let not all the trouble seem little before thee, that hath come upon us, on our kings, on our princes, and on our priests, and on our prophets, and on our fathers, and on all thy people, since the time of **the kings of Assyria** unto this day.
- Isaiah 7:17 The LORD shall bring upon thee, and upon thy people, and upon thy father's house, days that have not come, from the day that Ephraim departed from Judah; *even* the king of Assyria.
- Isaiah 7:18 And it shall come to pass in that day, *that* the LORD shall hiss for the fly that *is* in the uttermost part of the rivers of Egypt, and for the bee that *is* in **the land of**<u>Assyria.</u>
