

Perish

Genesis 41:36 And that food shall be for store to the land against the seven years of famine, which shall be in the land of Egypt; that the land [perish](#) not through the famine.

Exodus 19:21 And the LORD said unto Moses, Go down, charge the people, lest they break through unto the LORD to gaze, and many of them [perish](#).

Exodus 21:26 And if a man smite the eye of his servant, or the eye of his maid, that it [perish](#); he shall let him go free for his eye's sake.

Leviticus 26:38 And ye shall [perish](#) among the heathen, and the land of your enemies shall eat you up.

Numbers 17:12 And the children of Israel spake unto Moses, saying, Behold, we die, we [perish](#), we all [perish](#).

Numbers 24:20 And when he looked on Amalek, he took up his parable, and said, Amalek *was* the first of the nations; but his latter end *shall be* that he [perish](#) for ever.

Numbers 24:24 And ships *shall come* from the coast of Chittim, and shall afflict Asshur, and shall afflict Eber, and he also shall [perish](#) for ever.

Deuteronomy 4:26 I call heaven and earth to witness against you this day, that ye shall soon utterly [perish](#) from off the land whereunto ye go over Jordan to possess it; ye shall not prolong *your* days upon it, but shall utterly be destroyed.

Deuteronomy 8:19 And it shall be, if thou do at all forget the LORD thy God, and walk after other gods, and serve them, and worship them, I testify against you this day that ye shall surely [perish](#).

Deuteronomy 8:20 As the nations which the LORD destroyeth before your face, so shall ye [perish](#); because ye would not be obedient unto the voice of the LORD your God.

Deuteronomy 11:17 And *then* the LORD'S wrath be kindled against you, and he shut up the heaven, that there be no rain, and that the land yield not her fruit; and *lest* ye [perish](#) quickly from off the good land which the LORD giveth you.

Deuteronomy 26:5 And thou shalt speak and say before the LORD thy God, A Syrian ready to [perish](#) *was* my father, and he went down into Egypt, and sojourned there with a few, and became there a nation, great, mighty, and populous:

Deuteronomy 28:20 The LORD shall send upon thee cursing, vexation, and rebuke, in all that thou settest thine hand unto for to do, until thou be destroyed, and until thou [perish](#) quickly; because of the wickedness of thy doings, whereby thou hast forsaken me.

Deuteronomy 28:22 The LORD shall smite thee with a consumption, and with a fever, and with an inflammation, and with an extreme burning, and with the sword, and with blasting, and with mildew; and they shall pursue thee until thou [perish](#).

Deuteronomy 30:18 I denounce unto you this day, that ye shall surely [perish](#), *and that* ye shall not prolong *your* days upon the land, whither thou passest over Jordan to go to possess it.

Joshua 23:13 Know for a certainty that the LORD your God will no more drive out *any of* these nations from before you; but they shall be snares and traps unto you, and scourges in your sides, and thorns in your eyes, until ye [perish](#) from off this good land which the LORD your God hath given you.

Joshua 23:16 When ye have transgressed the covenant of the LORD your God, which he commanded you, and have gone and served other gods, and bowed yourselves to them; then shall the anger of the LORD be kindled against you, and ye shall [perish](#) quickly from off the good land which he hath given unto you.

Judges 5:31 So let all thine enemies [perish](#), O LORD: but *let* them that love him *be* as the sun when he goeth forth in his might. And the land had rest forty years.

1 Samuel 26:10 David said furthermore, *As* the LORD liveth, the LORD shall smite him; or his day shall come to die; or he shall descend into battle, and [perish](#).

1 Samuel 27:1 ¶ And David said in his heart, I shall now [perish](#) one day by the hand of Saul: *there is* nothing better for me than that I should speedily escape into the land of the Philistines; and Saul shall despair of me, to seek me any more in any coast of Israel: so shall I escape out of his hand.

2 Kings 9:8 For the whole house of Ahab shall [perish](#): and I will cut off from Ahab him that pisseth against the wall, and him that is shut up and left in Israel:

Esther 3:13 And the letters were sent by posts into all the king's provinces, to destroy, to kill, and to cause to [perish](#), all Jews, both young and old, little children and women, in one day, *even* upon the thirteenth *day* of the twelfth month, which is the month Adar, and *to take* the spoil of them for a prey.

Esther 4:16 Go, gather together all the Jews that are present in Shushan, and fast ye for me, and neither eat nor drink three days, night or day: I also and my maidens will fast likewise; and so will I go in unto the king, which *is* not according to the law: and if I [perish](#), I [perish](#).

Esther 7:4 For we are sold, I and my people, to be destroyed, to be slain, and to [perish](#). But if we had been sold for bondmen and bondwomen, I had held my tongue, although the enemy could not countervail the king's damage.

Esther 8:11 Wherein the king granted the Jews which *were* in every city to gather themselves together, and to stand for their life, to destroy, to slay, and to cause to [perish](#), all the power of the people and province that would assault them, *both* little ones and women, and *to take* the spoil of them for a prey,

Esther 9:28 And *that* these days *should be* remembered and kept throughout every generation, every family, every province, and every city; and *that* these days of Purim should not fail from among the Jews, nor the memorial of them [perish](#) from their seed.

Job 3:3 Let the day [perish](#) wherein I was born, and the night *in which* it was said, There is a man child conceived.

Job 4:9 By the blast of God they [perish](#), and by the breath of his nostrils are they consumed.

Job 4:20 They are destroyed from morning to evening: they [perish](#) for ever without any regarding *it*.

Job 6:18 The paths of their way are turned aside; they go to nothing, and [perish](#).

Job 8:13 So *are* the paths of all that forget God; and the hypocrite's hope shall [perish](#):

Job 18:17 His remembrance shall [perish](#) from the earth, and he shall have no name in the street.

Job 20:7 *Yet* he shall [perish](#) for ever like his own dung: they which have seen him shall say, Where *is* he?

Job 29:13 The blessing of him that was ready to [perish](#) came upon me: and I caused the widow's heart to sing for joy.

Job 31:19 If I have seen any [perish](#) for want of clothing, or any poor without covering;

Job 34:15 All flesh shall [perish](#) together, and man shall turn again unto dust.

Job 36:12 But if they obey not, they shall [perish](#) by the sword, and they shall die without knowledge.

Psalms 1:6 For the LORD knoweth the way of the righteous: but the way of the ungodly shall [perish](#).

Psalms 2:12 Kiss the Son, lest he be angry, and ye [perish](#) *from* the way, when his wrath is kindled but a little. Blessed *are* all they that put their trust in him.

Psalms 9:3 When mine enemies are turned back, they shall fall and [perish](#) at thy presence.

Psalms 9:18 For the needy shall not always be forgotten: the expectation of the poor shall *not* [perish](#) for ever.

Psalms 37:20 But the wicked shall [perish](#), and the enemies of the LORD *shall be* as the fat of lambs: they shall consume; into smoke shall they consume away.

Psalms 41:5 ¶ Mine enemies speak evil of me, When shall he die, and his name perish?

Psalms 49:10 For he seeth *that* wise men die, likewise the fool and the brutish person perish, and leave their wealth to others.

Psalms 49:12 Nevertheless man *being* in honour abideth not: he is like the beasts *that* perish.

Psalms 49:20 Man *that is* in honour, and understandeth not, is like the beasts *that* perish.

Psalms 68:2 As smoke is driven away, *so* drive *them* away: as wax melteth before the fire, *so* let the wicked perish at the presence of God.

Psalms 73:27 For, lo, they that are far from thee shall perish: thou hast destroyed all them that go a whoring from thee.

Psalms 80:16 *It is* burned with fire, *it is* cut down: they perish at the rebuke of thy countenance.

Psalms 83:17 Let them be confounded and troubled for ever; yea, let them be put to shame, and perish:

Psalms 92:9 For, lo, thine enemies, O LORD, for, lo, thine enemies shall perish; all the workers of iniquity shall be scattered.

Psalms 102:26 They shall perish, but thou shalt endure: yea, all of them shall wax old like a garment; as a vesture shalt thou change them, and they shall be changed:

Psalms 112:10 The wicked shall see *it*, and be grieved; he shall gnash with his teeth, and melt away: the desire of the wicked shall perish.

Psalms 146:4 His breath goeth forth, he returneth to his earth; in that very day his thoughts perish.

Proverbs 10:28 The hope of the righteous *shall be* gladness: but the expectation of the wicked shall perish.

Proverbs 11:7 ¶ When a wicked man dieth, *his* expectation shall perish: and the hope of unjust *men* perisheth.

Proverbs 11:10 ¶ When it goeth well with the righteous, the city rejoiceth: and when the wicked perish, *there is* shouting.

Proverbs 19:9 ¶ A false witness shall not be unpunished, and *he that* speaketh lies shall perish.

Proverbs 21:28 ¶ A false witness shall perish: but the man that heareth speaketh constantly.

Proverbs 28:28 ¶ When the wicked rise, men hide themselves: but when they perish, the righteous increase.

Proverbs 29:18 ¶ Where *there is* no vision, the people perish: but he that keepeth the law, happy *is* he.

Proverbs 31:6 Give strong drink unto him that is ready to perish, and wine unto those that be of heavy hearts.

Ecclesiastes 5:14 But those riches perish by evil travail: and he begetteth a son, and *there is* nothing in his hand.

Isaiah 26:14 *They are* dead, they shall not live; *they are* deceased, they shall not rise: therefore hast thou visited and destroyed them, and made all their memory to perish.

Isaiah 27:13 And it shall come to pass in that day, *that* the great trumpet shall be blown, and they shall come which were ready to perish in the land of Assyria, and the outcasts in the land of Egypt, and shall worship the LORD in the holy mount at Jerusalem.

Isaiah 29:14 Therefore, behold, I will proceed to do a marvellous work among this people, *even* a marvellous work and a wonder: for the wisdom of their wise *men* shall perish, and the understanding of their prudent *men* shall be hid.

Isaiah 41:11 Behold, all they that were incensed against thee shall be ashamed and confounded: they shall be as nothing; and they that strive with thee shall perish.

Isaiah 60:12 For the nation and kingdom that will not serve thee shall perish; yea, *those* nations shall be utterly wasted.

Jeremiah 4:9 And it shall come to pass at that day, saith the LORD, *that* the heart of the king shall perish, and the heart of the princes; and the priests shall be astonished, and the prophets shall wonder.

Jeremiah 6:21 Therefore thus saith the LORD, Behold, I will lay stumblingblocks before this people, and the fathers and the sons together shall fall upon them; the neighbour and his friend shall perish.

Jeremiah 10:11 Thus shall ye say unto them, The gods that have not made the heavens and the earth, *even* they shall perish from the earth, and from under these heavens.

Jeremiah 10:15 They *are* vanity, *and* the work of errors: in the time of their visitation they shall perish.

Jeremiah 18:18 ¶ Then said they, Come, and let us devise devices against Jeremiah; for the law shall not perish from the priest, nor counsel from the wise, nor the word from the prophet. Come, and let us smite him with the tongue, and let us not give heed to any of his words.

Jeremiah 27:10 For they prophesy a lie unto you, to remove you far from your land; and that I should drive you out, and ye should perish.

Jeremiah 27:15 For I have not sent them, saith the LORD, yet they prophesy a lie in my name; that I might drive you out, and that ye might perish, ye, and the prophets that prophesy unto you.

Jeremiah 40:15 Then Johanan the son of Kareah spake to Gedaliah in Mizpah secretly, saying, Let me go, I pray thee, and I will slay Ishmael the son of Nethaniah, and no man shall know *it*: wherefore should he slay thee, that all the Jews which are gathered unto thee should be scattered, and the remnant in Judah perish?

Jeremiah 48:8 And the spoiler shall come upon every city, and no city shall escape: the valley also shall perish, and the plain shall be destroyed, as the LORD hath spoken.

Jeremiah 51:18 They *are* vanity, the work of errors: in the time of their visitation they shall perish.

Ezekiel 7:26 Mischief shall come upon mischief, and rumour shall be upon rumour; then shall they seek a vision of the prophet; but the law shall perish from the priest, and counsel from the ancients.

Ezekiel 25:7 Behold, therefore I will stretch out mine hand upon thee, and will deliver thee for a spoil to the heathen; and I will cut thee off from the people, and I will cause thee to perish out of the countries: I will destroy thee; and thou shalt know that I *am* the LORD.

Daniel 2:18 That they would desire mercies of the God of heaven concerning this secret; that Daniel and his fellows should not perish with the rest of the wise *men* of Babylon.

Amos 1:8 And I will cut off the inhabitant from Ashdod, and him that holdeth the sceptre from Ashkelon, and I will turn mine hand against Ekron: and the remnant of the Philistines shall perish, saith the Lord GOD.

Amos 2:14 Therefore the flight shall perish from the swift, and the strong shall not strengthen his force, neither shall the mighty deliver himself:

Amos 3:15 And I will smite the winter house with the summer house; and the houses of ivory shall perish, and the great houses shall have an end, saith the LORD.

Jonah 1:6 So the shipmaster came to him, and said unto him, What meanest thou, O sleeper? arise, call upon thy God, if so be that God will think upon us, that we perish not.

Jonah 1:14 Wherefore they cried unto the LORD, and said, We beseech thee, O LORD, we beseech thee, let us not perish for this man's life, and lay not upon us innocent blood: for thou, O LORD, hast done as it pleased thee.

Jonah 3:9 Who can tell *if* God will turn and repent, and turn away from his fierce anger, that we perish not?

Zechariah 9:5 Ashkelon shall see *it*, and fear; Gaza also *shall see it*, and be very sorrowful, and Ekron; for her expectation shall be ashamed; and the king shall [perish](#) from Gaza, and Ashkelon shall not be inhabited.

Matthew 5:29 And if thy right eye offend thee, pluck it out, and cast *it* from thee: for it is profitable for thee that one of thy members should [perish](#), and not *that* thy whole body should be cast into hell.

Matthew 5:30 And if thy right hand offend thee, cut it off, and cast *it* from thee: for it is profitable for thee that one of thy members should [perish](#), and not *that* thy whole body should be cast into hell.

Matthew 8:25 And his disciples came to *him*, and awoke him, saying, Lord, save us: we [perish](#).

Matthew 9:17 Neither do men put new wine into old bottles: else the bottles break, and the wine runneth out, and the bottles [perish](#): but they put new wine into new bottles, and both are preserved.

Matthew 18:14 Even so it is not the will of your Father which is in heaven, that one of these little ones should [perish](#).

Matthew 26:52 Then said Jesus unto him, Put up again thy sword into his place: for all they that take the sword shall [perish](#) with the sword.

Mark 4:38 And he was in the hinder part of the ship, asleep on a pillow: and they awake him, and say unto him, Master, carest thou not that we [perish](#)?

Luke 5:37 And no man putteth new wine into old bottles; else the new wine will burst the bottles, and be spilled, and the bottles shall [perish](#).

Luke 8:24 And they came to him, and awoke him, saying, Master, master, we [perish](#). Then he arose, and rebuked the wind and the raging of the water: and they ceased, and there was a calm.

Luke 13:3 I tell you, Nay: but, except ye repent, ye shall all likewise [perish](#).

Luke 13:5 I tell you, Nay: but, except ye repent, ye shall all likewise [perish](#).

Luke 13:33 Nevertheless I must walk to day, and to morrow, and the *day* following: for it cannot be that a prophet [perish](#) out of Jerusalem.

Luke 15:17 And when he came to himself, he said, How many hired servants of my father's have bread enough and to spare, and I [perish](#) with hunger!

Luke 21:18 But there shall not an hair of your head [perish](#).

John 3:15 That whosoever believeth in him should not [perish](#), but have eternal life.

John 3:16 For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not [perish](#), but have everlasting life.

John 10:28 And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never [perish](#), neither shall any *man* pluck them out of my hand.

John 11:50 Nor consider that it is expedient for us, that one man should die for the people, and that the whole nation [perish](#) not.

Acts 8:20 But Peter said unto him, Thy money [perish](#) with thee, because thou hast thought that the gift of God may be purchased with money.

Acts 13:41 Behold, ye despisers, and wonder, and [perish](#): for I work a work in your days, a work which ye shall in no wise believe, though a man declare it unto you.

Romans 2:12 For as many as have sinned without law shall also [perish](#) without law: and as many as have sinned in the law shall be judged by the law;

1 Corinthians 1:18 For the preaching of the cross is to them that [perish](#) foolishness; but unto us which are saved it is the power of God.

1 Corinthians 8:11 And through thy knowledge shall the weak brother [perish](#), for whom Christ died?

2 Corinthians 2:15 For we are unto God a sweet savour of Christ, in them that are saved, and in them that [perish](#):

2 Corinthians 4:16 For which cause we faint not; but though our outward man perish, yet the inward *man* is renewed day by day.

Colossians 2:22 Which all are to perish with the using;) after the commandments and doctrines of men?

2 Thessalonians 2:10 And with all deceivableness of unrighteousness in them that perish; because they received not the love of the truth, that they might be saved.

Hebrews 1:11 They shall perish; but thou remainest; and they all shall wax old as doth a garment;

2 Peter 2:12 But these, as natural brute beasts, made to be taken and destroyed, speak evil of the things that they understand not; and shall utterly perish in their own corruption;

2 Peter 3:9 ¶ The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance.
