Sodom

- Genesis 10:19 And the border of the Canaanites was from Sidon, as thou comest to Gerar, unto Gaza; as thou goest, unto Sodom, and Gomorrah, and Admah, and Zeboim, even unto Lasha.
- Genesis 13:10 ¶ And Lot lifted up his eyes, and beheld all the plain of Jordan, that it *was* well watered every where, before the LORD destroyed <u>Sodom</u> and Gomorrah, *even* as the garden of the LORD, like the land of Egypt, as thou comest unto Zoar.
- Genesis 13:12 Abram dwelled in the land of Canaan, and Lot dwelled in the cities of the plain, and pitched *his* tent toward <u>Sodom</u>.
- Genesis 13:13 But the men of Sodom were wicked and sinners before the LORD exceedingly.
- Genesis 14:2 *That these* made war with Bera king of <u>Sodom</u>, and with Birsha king of Gomorrah, Shinab king of Admah, and Shemeber king of Zeboiim, and the king of Bela, which is Zoar.
- Genesis 14:8 And there went out the king of <u>Sodom</u>, and the king of Gomorrah, and the king of Admah, and the king of Zeboiim, and the king of Bela (the same *is* Zoar;) and they joined battle with them in the vale of Siddim;
- Genesis 14:10 And the vale of Siddim *was full of* slimepits; and the kings of <u>Sodom</u> and Gomorrah fled, and fell there; and they that remained fled to the mountain.
- Genesis 14:11 And they took all the goods of <u>Sodom</u> and Gomorrah, and all their victuals, and went their way.
- Genesis 14:12 And they took Lot, Abram's brother's son, who dwelt in <u>Sodom</u>, and his goods, and departed.
- Genesis 14:17 ¶ And the king of <u>Sodom</u> went out to meet him after his return from the slaughter of Chedorlaomer, and of the kings that *were* with him, at the valley of Shaveh, which *is* the king's dale.
- Genesis 14:21 ¶ And the king of <u>Sodom</u> said unto Abram, Give me the persons, and take the goods to thyself.
- Genesis 14:22 And Abram said to the king of <u>Sodom</u>, I have lift up mine hand unto the LORD, the most high God, the possessor of heaven and earth,
- Genesis 18:16 ¶ And the men rose up from thence, and looked toward <u>Sodom</u>: and Abraham went with them to bring them on the way.
- Genesis 18:20 And the LORD said, Because the cry of <u>Sodom</u> and Gomorrah is great, and because their sin is very grievous;
- Genesis 18:22 And the men turned their faces from thence, and went toward <u>Sodom</u>: but Abraham stood yet before the LORD.
- Genesis 18:26 And the LORD said, If I find in <u>Sodom</u> fifty righteous within the city, then I will spare all the place for their sakes.
- Genesis 19:1 ¶ And there came two angels to <u>Sodom</u> at even; and Lot sat in the gate of <u>Sodom</u>: and Lot seeing *them* rose up to meet them; and he bowed himself with his face toward the ground;
- Genesis 19:4 ¶ But before they lay down, the men of the city, *even* the men of <u>Sodom</u>, compassed the house round, both old and young, all the people from every quarter:
- Genesis 19:24 ¶ Then the LORD rained upon <u>Sodom</u> and upon Gomorrah brimstone and fire from the LORD out of heaven;
- Genesis 19:28 And he looked toward <u>Sodom</u> and Gomorrah, and toward all the land of the plain, and beheld, and, lo, the smoke of the country went up as the smoke of a furnace.
- Deuteronomy 29:23 *And that* the whole land thereof *is* brimstone, and salt, *and* burning, *that* it is not sown, nor beareth, nor any grass growth therein, like the overthrow of <u>Sodom</u>, and Gomorrah, Admah, and Zeboim, which the LORD overthrew in his anger, and in his wrath:

- Deuteronomy 32:32 For their vine *is* of the vine of <u>Sodom</u>, and of the fields of Gomorrah: their grapes *are* grapes of gall, their clusters *are* bitter:
- Isaiah 1:9 Except the LORD of hosts had left unto us a very small remnant, we should have been as Sodom, *and* we should have been like unto Gomorrah.
- Isaiah 1:10 ¶ Hear the word of the LORD, ye rulers of <u>Sodom</u>; give ear unto the law of our God, ye people of Gomorrah.
- Isaiah 3:9 ¶ The shew of their countenance doth witness against them; and they declare their sin as \underline{Sodom} , they hide it not. Woe unto their soul! for they have rewarded evil unto themselves.
- Isaiah 13:19 ¶ And Babylon, the glory of kingdoms, the beauty of the Chaldees' excellency, shall be as when God overthrew Sodom and Gomorrah.
- Jeremiah 23:14 I have seen also in the prophets of Jerusalem an horrible thing: they commit adultery, and walk in lies: they strengthen also the hands of evildoers, that none doth return from his wickedness: they are all of them unto me as <u>Sodom</u>, and the inhabitants thereof as Gomorrah.
- Jeremiah 49:18 As in the overthrow of <u>Sodom</u> and Gomorrah and the neighbour *cities* thereof, saith the LORD, no man shall abide there, neither shall a son of man dwell in it.
- Jeremiah 50:40 As God overthrew <u>Sodom</u> and Gomorrah and the neighbour *cities* thereof, saith the LORD; *so* shall no man abide there, neither shall any son of man dwell therein.
- Lamentations 4:6 For the punishment of the iniquity of the daughter of my people is greater than the punishment of the sin of <u>Sodom</u>, that was overthrown as in a moment, and no hands stayed on her.
- Ezekiel 16:46 And thine elder sister *is* Samaria, she and her daughters that dwell at thy left hand: and thy younger sister, that dwelleth at thy right hand, *is* Sodom and her daughters.
- Ezekiel 16:48 *As* I live, saith the Lord GOD, <u>Sodom</u> thy sister hath not done, she nor her daughters, as thou hast done, thou and thy daughters.
- Ezekiel 16:49 Behold, this was the iniquity of thy sister <u>Sodom</u>, pride, fulness of bread, and abundance of idleness was in her and in her daughters, neither did she strengthen the hand of the poor and needy.
- Ezekiel 16:53 When I shall bring again their captivity, the captivity of <u>Sodom</u> and her daughters, and the captivity of Samaria and her daughters, then *will I bring again* the captivity of thy captives in the midst of them:
- Ezekiel 16:55 When thy sisters, <u>Sodom</u> and her daughters, shall return to their former estate, and Samaria and her daughters shall return to their former estate, then thou and thy daughters shall return to your former estate.
- Ezekiel 16:56 For thy sister <u>Sodom</u> was not mentioned by thy mouth in the day of thy pride, Amos 4:11 I have overthrown *some* of you, as God overthrew <u>Sodom</u> and Gomorrah, and ye were as a firebrand plucked out of the burning: yet have ye not returned unto me, saith the LORD.
- Zephaniah 2:9 Therefore *as* I live, saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel, Surely Moab shall be as <u>Sodom</u>, and the children of Ammon as Gomorrah, *even* the breeding of nettles, and saltpits, and a perpetual desolation: the residue of my people shall spoil them, and the remnant of my people shall possess them.
- Matthew 10:15 Verily I say unto you, It shall be more tolerable for the land of <u>Sodom</u> and Gomorrha in the day of judgment, than for that city.
- Matthew 11:23 And thou, Capernaum, which art exalted unto heaven, shalt be brought down to hell: for if the mighty works, which have been done in thee, had been done in <u>Sodom</u>, it would have remained until this day.
- Matthew 11:24 But I say unto you, That it shall be more tolerable for the land of <u>Sodom</u> in the day of judgment, than for thee.

- Mark 6:11 And whosoever shall not receive you, nor hear you, when ye depart thence, shake off the dust under your feet for a testimony against them. Verily I say unto you, It shall be more tolerable for Sodom and Gomorrha in the day of judgment, than for that city.
- Luke 10:12 But I say unto you, that it shall be more tolerable in that day for <u>Sodom</u>, than for that city.
- Luke 17:29 But the same day that Lot went out of <u>Sodom</u> it rained fire and brimstone from heaven, and destroyed *them* all.
- 2 Peter 2:6 And turning the cities of <u>Sodom</u> and Gomorrha into ashes condemned *them* with an overthrow, making *them* an ensample unto those that after should live ungodly;
- Jude 1:7 Even as <u>Sodom</u> and Gomorrha, and the cities about them in like manner, giving themselves over to fornication, and going after strange flesh, are set forth for an example, suffering the vengeance of eternal fire.
- Revelation 11:8 And their dead bodies *shall lie* in the street of the great city, which spiritually is called <u>Sodom</u> and Egypt, where also our Lord was crucified.
