Genesis 4:5 But unto Cain and to his offering he had not respect. And Cain was very wroth <02734>, and his countenance fell.

Genesis 4:6 ¶ And the LORD said unto Cain, Why art thou wroth <02734>? and why is thy countenance fallen?

Genesis 18:30 And he said *unto him*, Oh let not the Lord be angry <02734>, and I will speak: Peradventure there shall thirty be found there. And he said, I will not do *it*, if I find thirty there.

Genesis 18:32 And he said, Oh let not the Lord be angry <02734>, and I will speak yet but this once: Peradventure ten shall be found there. And he said, I will not destroy *it* for ten's sake.

Genesis 30:2 And Jacob's anger was kindled <02734> against Rachel: and he said, *Am I* in God's stead, who hath withheld from thee the fruit of the womb?

Genesis 31:35 And she said to her father, Let it not displeas <02734> my lord that I cannot rise up before thee; for the custom of women *is* upon me. And he searched, but found not the images.

Genesis 31:36 ¶ And Jacob was wroth <02734>, and chode with Laban: and Jacob answered and said to Laban, What *is* my trespass? what *is* my sin, that thou hast so hotly pursued after me?

Genesis 34:7 And the sons of Jacob came out of the field when they heard *it*: and the men were grieved, and they were very wroth <02734>, because he had wrought folly in Israel in lying with Jacob's daughter; which thing ought not to be done.

Genesis 39:19 ¶ And it came to pass, when his master heard the words of his wife, which she spake unto him, saying, After this manner did thy servant to me; that his wrath was kindled <02734>.

Genesis 44:18 ¶ Then Judah came near unto him, and said, Oh my lord, let thy servant, I pray thee, speak a word in my lord's ears, and let not thine anger burn <02734> against thy servant: for thou *art* even as Pharaoh.

Genesis 45:5 Now therefore be not grieved, nor angry <02734> with yourselves, that ye sold me hither: for God did send me before you to preserve life.

Exodus 4:14 And the anger of the LORD was kindled <02734> against Moses, and he said, *Is* not Aaron the Levite thy brother? I know that he can speak well. And also, behold, he cometh forth to meet thee: and when he seeth thee, he will be glad in his heart.

Exodus 22:24 And my wrath shall wax hot <02734>, and I will kill you with the sword; and your wives shall be widows, and your children fatherless.

Exodus 32:10 Now therefore let me alone, that my wrath may wax hot <02734> against them, and that I may consume them: and I will make of thee a great nation.

Exodus 32:11 And Moses besought the LORD his God, and said, LORD, why doth thy wrath wax hot <02734> against thy people, which thou hast brought forth out of the land of Egypt with great power, and with a mighty hand?

Exodus 32:19 And it came to pass, as soon as he came nigh unto the camp, that he saw the calf, and the dancing: and Moses' anger waxed hot <02734>, and he cast the tables out of his hands, and brake them beneath the mount.

Exodus 32:22 And Aaron said, Let not the anger of my lord wax hot <02734>: thou knowest the people, that they *are set* on mischief.

Numbers 11:1 ¶ And *when* the people complained, it displeased the LORD: and the LORD heard *it*; and his anger was kindled <02734>; and the fire of the LORD burnt among them, and consumed *them that were* in the uttermost parts of the camp.

Numbers 11:10 Then Moses heard the people weep throughout their families, every man in the door of his tent: and the anger of the LORD was kindled <02734> greatly; Moses also was displeased.

Numbers 11:33 And while the flesh *was* yet between their teeth, ere it was chewed, the wrath of the LORD was kindled <02734> against the people, and the LORD smote the people with a very great plague.

Numbers 12:9 And the anger of the LORD was kindled <02734> against them; and he departed.

Numbers 16:15 And Moses was very wroth <02734>, and said unto the LORD, Respect not thou their offering: I have not taken one ass from them, neither have I hurt one of them.

Numbers 22:22 ¶ And God's anger was kindled <02734> because he went: and the angel of the LORD stood in the way for an adversary against him. Now he was riding upon his ass, and his two servants *were* with him.

Numbers 22:27 And when the ass saw the angel of the LORD, she fell down under Balaam: and Balaam's anger was kindled <02734>, and he smote the ass with a staff.

Numbers 24:10 ¶ And Balak's anger was kindled <02734> against Balaam, and he smote his hands together: and Balak said unto Balaam, I called thee to curse mine enemies, and, behold, thou hast altogether blessed *them* these three times.

Numbers 25:3 And Israel joined himself unto Baalpeor: and the anger of the LORD was kindled <02734> against Israel.

Numbers 32:10 And the LORD'S anger was kindled <02734> the same time, and he sware, saying,

Numbers 32:13 And the LORD'S anger was kindled <02734> against Israel, and he made them wander in the wilderness forty years, until all the generation, that had done evil in the sight of the LORD, was consumed.

Deuteronomy 6:15 (For the LORD thy God *is* a jealous God among you) lest the anger of the LORD thy God be kindled <02734> against thee, and destroy thee from off the face of the earth.

Deuteronomy 7:4 For they will turn away thy son from following me, that they may serve other gods: so will the anger of the LORD be kindled <02734> against you, and destroy thee suddenly.

Deuteronomy 11:17 And *then* the LORD'S wrath be kindled <02734> against you, and he shut up the heaven, that there be no rain, and that the land yield not her fruit; and *lest* ye perish quickly from off the good land which the LORD giveth you.

Deuteronomy 29:27 And the anger of the LORD was kindled <02734> against this land, to bring upon it all the curses that are written in this book:

Deuteronomy 31:17 Then my anger shall be kindled <02734> against them in that day, and I will forsake them, and I will hide my face from them, and they shall be devoured, and many evils and troubles shall befall them; so that they will say in that day, Are not these evils come upon us, because our God *is* not among us?

Joshua 7:1 ¶ But the children of Israel committed a trespass in the accursed thing: for Achan, the son of Carmi, the son of Zabdi, the son of Zerah, of the tribe of Judah, took of the accursed thing: and the anger of the LORD was kindled <02734> against the children of Israel.

Joshua 23:16 When ye have transgressed the covenant of the LORD your God, which he commanded you, and have gone and served other gods, and bowed yourselves to them; then shall the anger of the LORD be kindled <02734> against you, and ye shall perish quickly from off the good land which he hath given unto you.

Judges 2:14 And the anger of the LORD was hot <02734> against Israel, and he delivered them into the hands of spoilers that spoiled them, and he sold them into the hands of their enemies round about, so that they could not any longer stand before their enemies.

Judges 2:20 And the anger of the LORD was hot <02734> against Israel; and he said, Because that this people hath transgressed my covenant which I commanded their fathers, and have not hearkened unto my voice;

Judges 3:8 ¶ Therefore the anger of the LORD was hot <02734> against Israel, and he sold them into the hand of Chushanrishathaim king of Mesopotamia: and the children of Israel served Chushanrishathaim eight years.

Judges 6:39 And Gideon said unto God, Let not thine anger be hot <02734> against me, and I will speak but this once: let me prove, I pray thee, but this once with the fleece; let it now be dry only upon the fleece, and upon all the ground let there be dew.

Judges 9:30 And when Zebul the ruler of the city heard the words of Gaal the son of Ebed, his anger was kindled <02734>.

Judges 10:7 And the anger of the LORD was hot <02734> against Israel, and he sold them into the hands of the Philistines, and into the hands of the children of Ammon.

Judges 14:19 And the Spirit of the LORD came upon him, and he went down to Ashkelon, and slew thirty men of them, and took their spoil, and gave change of garments unto them which expounded the riddle. And his anger was kindled <02734>, and he went up to his father's house.

1 Samuel 11:6 And the Spirit of God came upon Saul when he heard those tidings, and his anger was kindled <02734> greatly.

1 Samuel 15:11 It repenteth me that I have set up Saul *to be* king: for he is turned back from following me, and hath not performed my commandments. And it grieved <02734> Samuel; and he cried unto the LORD all night.

1 Samuel 17:28 And Eliab his eldest brother heard when he spake unto the men; and Eliab's anger was kindled <02734> against David, and he said, Why camest thou down hither? and with whom hast thou left those few sheep in the wilderness? I know thy pride, and the naughtiness of thine heart; for thou art come down that thou mightest see the battle.

1 Samuel 18:8 And Saul was very wroth <02734>, and the saying displeased him; and he said, They have ascribed unto David ten thousands, and to me they have ascribed *but* thousands: and *what* can he have more but the kingdom?

1 Samuel 20:7 If he say thus, *It is* well; thy servant shall have peace: but if he be very <02734> wroth <02734>, *then* be sure that evil is determined by him.

1 Samuel 20:30 Then Saul's anger was kindled <02734> against Jonathan, and he said unto him, Thou son of the perverse rebellious *woman*, do not I know that thou hast

chosen the son of Jesse to thine own confusion, and unto the confusion of thy mother's nakedness?

- 2 Samuel 3:8 Then was Abner very wroth [<02734>](#) for the words of Ishbosheth, and said, *Am* I a dog's head, which against Judah do shew kindness this day unto the house of Saul thy father, to his brethren, and to his friends, and have not delivered thee into the hand of David, that thou chargest me to day with a fault concerning this woman?
- 2 Samuel 6:7 And the anger of the LORD was kindled [<02734>](#) against Uzzah; and God smote him there for *his* error; and there he died by the ark of God.
- 2 Samuel 6:8 And David was displeased [<02734>](#), because the LORD had made a breach upon Uzzah: and he called the name of the place Perezuzzah to this day.
- 2 Samuel 12:5 And David's anger was greatly kindled [<02734>](#) against the man; and he said to Nathan, *As* the LORD liveth, the man that hath done this *thing* shall surely die:
- 2 Samuel 13:21 ¶ But when king David heard of all these things, he was very wroth [<02734>](#).
- 2 Samuel 19:42 And all the men of Judah answered the men of Israel, Because the king *is* near of kin to us: wherefore then be ye angry [<02734>](#) for this matter? have we eaten at all of the king's *cost*? or hath he given us any gift?
- 2 Samuel 22:8 Then the earth shook and trembled; the foundations of heaven moved and shook, because he was wroth [<02734>](#).
- 2 Samuel 24:1 ¶ And again the anger of the LORD was kindled [<02734>](#) against Israel, and he moved David against them to say, Go, number Israel and Judah.
- 2 Kings 13:3 And the anger of the LORD was kindled [<02734>](#) against Israel, and he delivered them into the hand of Hazael king of Syria, and into the hand of Benhadad the son of Hazael, all *their* days.
- 2 Kings 23:26 Notwithstanding the LORD turned not from the fierceness of his great wrath, wherewith his anger was kindled [<02734>](#) against Judah, because of all the provocations that Manasseh had provoked him withal.
- 1 Chronicles 13:10 And the anger of the LORD was kindled [<02734>](#) against Uzza, and he smote him, because he put his hand to the ark: and there he died before God.
- 1 Chronicles 13:11 And David was displeased [<02734>](#), because the LORD had made a breach upon Uzza: wherefore that place is called Perezuzza to this day.
- 2 Chronicles 25:10 Then Amaziah separated them, *to wit*, the army that was come to him out of Ephraim, to go home again: wherefore their anger was greatly kindled [<02734>](#) against Judah, and they returned home in great anger.
- 2 Chronicles 25:15 Wherefore the anger of the LORD was kindled [<02734>](#) against Amaziah, and he sent unto him a prophet, which said unto him, Why hast thou sought after the gods of the people, which could not deliver their own people out of thine hand?
- Nehemiah 3:20 After him Baruch the son of Zabbai earnestly [<02734>](#) repaired the other piece, from the turning *of the wall* unto the door of the house of Eliashib the high priest.
- Nehemiah 4:1 ¶ But it came to pass, that when Sanballat heard that we builded the wall, he was wroth [<02734>](#), and took great indignation, and mocked the Jews.
- Nehemiah 4:7 ¶ But it came to pass, *that* when Sanballat, and Tobiah, and the Arabians, and the Ammonites, and the Ashdodites, heard that the walls of Jerusalem were made up, *and* that the breaches began to be stopped, then they were very wroth [<02734>](#),
- Nehemiah 5:6 ¶ And I was very angry [<02734>](#) when I heard their cry and these words.
- Job 19:11 He hath also kindled [<02734>](#) his wrath against me, and he counteth me unto him as *one of* his enemies.

Job 32:2 Then was kindled [<02734>](#) the wrath of Elihu the son of Barachel the Buzite, of the kindred of Ram: against Job was his wrath kindled [<02734>](#), because he justified himself rather than God.

Job 32:3 Also against his three friends was his wrath kindled [<02734>](#), because they had found no answer, and *yet* had condemned Job.

Job 32:5 When Elihu saw that *there was* no answer in the mouth of *these* three men, then his wrath was kindled [<02734>](#).

Job 42:7 ¶ And it was *so*, that after the LORD had spoken these words unto Job, the LORD said to Eliphaz the Temanite, My wrath is kindled [<02734>](#) against thee, and against thy two friends: for ye have not spoken of me *the thing that is* right, as my servant Job *hath*.

Psalms 18:7 Then the earth shook and trembled; the foundations also of the hills moved and were shaken, because he was wroth [<02734>](#).

Psalms 37:1 ¶ <<A Psalm of David.>> Fret [<02734>](#) not thyself because of evildoers, neither be thou envious against the workers of iniquity.

Psalms 37:7 ¶ Rest in the LORD, and wait patiently for him: fret [<02734>](#) not thyself because of him who prospereth in his way, because of the man who bringeth wicked devices to pass.

Psalms 37:8 Cease from anger, and forsake wrath: fret [<02734>](#) not thyself in any wise to do evil.

Psalms 106:40 Therefore was the wrath of the LORD kindled [<02734>](#) against his people, insomuch that he abhorred his own inheritance.

Psalms 124:3 Then they had swallowed us up quick, when their wrath was kindled [<02734>](#) against us:

Proverbs 24:19 ¶ Fret [<02734>](#) not thyself because of evil *men*, neither be thou envious at the wicked;

Isaiah 5:25 Therefore is the anger of the LORD kindled [<02734>](#) against his people, and he hath stretched forth his hand against them, and hath smitten them: and the hills did tremble, and their carcasses *were* torn in the midst of the streets. For all this his anger is not turned away, but his hand *is* stretched out still.

Isaiah 41:11 Behold, all they that were incensed [<02734>](#) against thee shall be ashamed and confounded: they shall be as nothing; and they that strive with thee shall perish.

Isaiah 45:24 Surely, shall *one* say, in the LORD have I righteousness and strength: *even* to him shall *men* come; and all that are incensed [<02734>](#) against him shall be ashamed.

Hosea 8:5 Thy calf, O Samaria, hath cast *thee* off; mine anger is kindled [<02734>](#) against them: how long *will it be* ere they attain to innocency?

Jonah 4:1 But it displeased Jonah exceedingly, and he was very angry [<02734>](#).

Jonah 4:4 Then said the LORD, Doest thou well to be angry [<02734>](#)?

Jonah 4:9 And God said to Jonah, Doest thou well to be angry [<02734>](#) for the gourd? And he said, I do well to be angry [<02734>](#), *even* unto death.

Habakkuk 3:8 Was the LORD displeased [<02734>](#) against the rivers? *was* thine anger against the rivers? *was* thy wrath against the sea, that thou didst ride upon thine horses *and* thy chariots of salvation?

Zechariah 10:3 Mine anger was kindled [<02734>](#) against the shepherds, and I punished the goats: for the LORD of hosts hath visited his flock the house of Judah, and hath made them as his goodly horse in the battle.
