Numbers 23:10 Who can count <04487> the dust of Jacob, and the number of the fourth *part* of Israel? Let me die the death of the righteous, and let my last end be like his!

2 Samuel 24:1 ¶ And again the anger of the LORD was kindled against Israel, and he moved David against them to say, Go, number <04487> Israel and Judah.

Deuteronomy 25:12 Then thou shalt cut off her hand, thine eye shall not pity <02347> *her*.

1 Samuel 24:10 Behold, this day thine eyes have seen how that the LORD had delivered thee to day into mine hand in the cave: and *some* bade *me* kill thee: but *mine eye* spared <02347> thee; and I said, I will not put forth mine hand against my lord; for he *is* the LORD'S anointed.

Deuteronomy 12:28 Observe and hear all these words which I command thee, that it may go well <03190> with thee, and with thy children after thee for ever, when thou doest *that which is* good and right in the sight of the LORD thy God.

Deuteronomy 13:14 Then shalt thou enquire, and make search, and ask diligently <03190>; and, behold, *if it be* truth, *and* the thing certain, *that* such abomination is wrought among you;

Deuteronomy 17:4 And it be told thee, and thou hast heard *of it*, and enquired diligently <03190>, and, behold, *it be* true, *and* the thing certain, *that* such abomination is wrought in Israel:

Deuteronomy 18:17 And the LORD said unto me, They have well <03190> *spoken that* which they have spoken.

Deuteronomy 19:18 And the judges shall make diligent [<03190>](#) inquisition: and, behold, *if* the witness *be* a false witness, *and* hath testified falsely against his brother;

Deuteronomy 22:7 *But* thou shalt in any wise let the dam go, and take the young to thee; that it may be well [<03190>](#) with thee, and *that* thou mayest prolong *thy* days.

Deuteronomy 27:8 And thou shalt write upon the stones all the words of this law very [<03190>](#) plainly.

Judges 18:20 And the priest's heart was glad [<03190>](#), and he took the ephod, and the teraphim, and the graven image, and went in the midst of the people.

Judges 19:6 And they sat down, and did eat and drink both of them together: for the damsel's father had said unto the man, Be content, I pray thee, and tarry all night, and let thine heart be merry [<03190>](#).

Ruth 3:1 ¶ Then Naomi her mother in law said unto her, My daughter, shall I not seek rest for thee, that it may be well [<03190>](#) with thee?

Ruth 3:7 And when Boaz had eaten and drunk, and his heart was merry [<03190>](#), he went to lie down at the end of the heap of corn: and she came softly, and uncovered his feet, and laid her down.

Ruth 3:10 And he said, Blessed *be* thou of the LORD, my daughter: *for* thou hast shewed [<03190>](#) more kindness in the latter end than at the beginning, inasmuch as thou followedst not young men, whether poor or rich.

1 Samuel 2:32 And thou shalt see an enemy *in my* habitation, in all *the wealth* which God shall give [<03190>](#) Israel: and there shall not be an old man in thine house for ever.

- 1 Samuel 16:17 And Saul said unto his servants, Provide me now a man that can play well [<03190>](#), and bring *him* to me.
- 1 Samuel 18:5 And David went out whithersoever Saul sent him, *and* behaved himself wisely: and Saul set him over the men of war, and he was accepted [<03190>](#) in the sight of all the people, and also in the sight of Saul's servants.
- 1 Samuel 20:13 The LORD do so and much more to Jonathan: but if it please [<03190>](#) my father *to do* thee evil, then I will shew it thee, and send thee away, that thou mayest go in peace: and the LORD be with thee, as he hath been with my father.

Exodus 34:6 And the LORD passed by before him, and proclaimed, The LORD, The LORD God, merciful and gracious, longsuffering, and abundant in goodness <02617> and truth,
