## Good things happened in people's houses

- 3624 οικος oikos Household/Family
- Acts 2:2 And suddenly there came a sound from heaven as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled all the house where they were sitting.
- Acts 2:46 And they, continuing daily with one accord in the temple, and **breaking bread from house** to **house**, did eat their meat with gladness and singleness of heart,
- Acts 5:42 And daily in the temple, and **in every <u>house</u>**, they ceased not to teach and preach Jesus Christ.
- Acts 9:11 And the Lord *said* unto him, Arise, and go into the street which is called Straight, and enquire in the **house** of **Judas** for *one* called Saul, of Tarsus: for, behold, he prays,
- Acts 9:17 And Ananias went his way, and **entered into the <u>house</u>**; and putting his hands on him said, Brother Saul, the Lord, *even* Jesus, that appeared unto thee in the way as thou camest, hath sent me, that thou mightest receive thy sight, and be filled with the Holy Ghost.
- Acts 10:2 *A* devout *man*, and one that **feared God with all his <u>house</u>**, which gave much alms to the people, and prayed to God alway.
- Acts 10:6 He lodgeth with one Simon a tanner, whose <u>house</u> is by the sea side: he shall tell thee what thou oughtest to do.
- Acts 10:17 Now while Peter doubted in himself what this vision which he had seen should mean, behold, the men which were sent from Cornelius had made enquiry for **Simon's house**, and stood before the gate,
- Acts 10:22 And they said, Cornelius the centurion, a just man, and one that feareth God, and of good report among all the nation of the Jews, was warned from God by an holy angel to send for you into his house, and to hear words of you.
- Acts 10:30 And Cornelius said, Four days ago I was fasting until this hour; and at the ninth hour I prayed in my house, and, behold, a man stood before me in bright clothing,
- Acts 10:32 Send therefore to Joppa, and call hither Simon, whose surname is Peter; **he is lodged in the house** of *one* Simon a tanner by the sea side: who, when he cometh, shall speak unto thee
- Acts 11:11 And, behold, immediately there were three men already **come unto the <u>house</u>** where I was, sent from Caesarea unto me.
- Acts 11:12 And the Spirit bade me go with them, nothing doubting. Moreover these six brethren accompanied me, and we entered into the man's <u>house</u>:
- Acts 11:13 And he shewed us how he had seen an angel in his <u>house</u>, which stood and said unto him, Send men to Joppa, and call for Simon, whose surname is Peter;
- Acts 11:14 Who shall tell thee words, whereby thou and **all thy house shall be saved**.
- Acts 12:12 And when he had considered *the thing*, he came to **the <u>house</u> of Mary the mother of John,** whose surname was Mark; where many were gathered together praying.
- Acts 16:15 And when she was baptized, and her household, she besought *us*, saying, If ye have judged me to be faithful to the Lord, **come into my** <u>house</u>, and abide *there*. And she constrained us.
- Acts 16:31 And they said, Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and you will be saved, **and your house.**
- Acts 16:32 And they spake unto him the word of the Lord, and to all that were in his house.
- Acts 16:34 And when he had **brought them into his <u>house</u>**, he set meat before them, and rejoiced, **believing in God with all his <u>house</u>**.

- Acts 16:40 And they went out of the prison, and **entered into** *the* <u>house</u> *of* Lydia: and when they had seen the brethren, they comforted them, and departed.
- Acts 18:7 And he departed thence, and entered into a certain *man's* <u>house</u>, named Justus, *one* that worshipped God, **whose** <u>house</u> <u>joined</u> hard to the synagogue.
- Acts 18:8 And Crispus, the chief ruler of the synagogue, believed on the Lord with **all his house**; and many of the Corinthians hearing believed, and were baptized.
- Acts 20:20 *And* how I kept back nothing that was profitable *unto you*, but have showed you, and have taught you publicly, and **from house** to house,
- Acts 21:8 And the next *day* we that were of Paul's company departed, and came unto Caesarea: and we entered into **the <u>house</u> of Philip the evangelist**, which was *one* of the seven; and abode with him.
- Acts 28:30 And Paul dwelt two whole years in **his own hired <u>house</u>**, and received all that came in unto him,
- Romans 16:5 (Priscilla and Aquila) Likewise *greet* the church that is in their <u>house</u>. Salute my wellbeloved Epaenetus, who is the firstfruits of Achaia unto Christ.
- 1 Corinthians 1:11 For it hath been declared unto me of you, my brethren, by them *which are of the house* of Chloe, that there are contentions among you.
- 1 Corinthians 16:15 I beseech you, brethren, (ye **know the <u>house</u> of Stephanas**, that it is the firstfruits of Achaia, and *that* they have addicted themselves to the ministry of the saints,)
- 1 Corinthians 16:19 The churches of Asia salute you. **Aquila and Priscilla** salute you much in the Lord, with the **church that is in their <u>house</u>**.
- Colossians 4:15 Salute the brethren which are in Laodicea, and Nymphas, and the church which is in his <u>house</u>.
- 2 Timothy 1:16 **The Lord give mercy unto the <u>house</u> of Onesiphorus;** for he oft refreshed me, and was not ashamed of my chain:
- Philemon 1:2 And to *our* beloved Apphia, and Archippus our fellowsoldier, **and to the church in thy house**:
- Hebrews 11:7 By faith Noah, being warned of God of things not seen as yet, moved with fear, **prepared an ark to the saving of his house**; by the which he condemned the world, and became heir of the righteousness which is by faith.
- 1 Peter 2:5 You also, as lively stones, are **built up a spiritual <u>house</u>**, an holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices, acceptable to God by Jesus Christ.
- 2 John 1:10 If there come any unto you, and bring not this doctrine, **receive him not into** *your* **house**, neither bid him God speed:
