Greek words are keyed to Strong's numbering system where every Greek word is given an number, thus you can discover how often a word is used in the New Testament and how it was used.

Christ <5547> Christos Jesus <2424> Iesous King Jesus (54 times)

- Romans 3:24 Being justified freely by his grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus:
- Romans 8:1 ¶ *There is* therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.
- Romans 8:2 For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus hath made me free from the law of sin and death.
- Romans 8:39 Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.
- Romans 15:5 ¶ Now the God of patience and consolation grant you to be likeminded one toward another according to Christ Jesus:
- Romans 16:3 Greet Priscilla and Aquila my helpers in Christ Jesus:
- 1 Corinthians 1:2 Unto the church of God which is at Corinth, to them that are sanctified in Christ Jesus, called *to be* saints, with all that in every place call upon the name of Jesus Christ our Lord, both theirs and ours:
- 1 Corinthians 1:30 But of him are ye in Christ Jesus, who of God is made unto us wisdom, and righteousness, and sanctification, and redemption:
- 1 Corinthians 4:15 For though ye have ten thousand instructors in Christ, yet *have ye* not many fathers: for in Christ Jesus I have begotten you through the gospel.
- 1 Corinthians 15:31 I protest by your rejoicing which I have in Christ Jesus our Lord, I die daily.
- 1 Corinthians 16:24 My love *be* with you all in Christ Jesus. Amen.
- 2 Corinthians 4:5 For we preach not ourselves, but Christ Jesus the Lord; and ourselves your servants for Jesus' sake.
- Galatians 2:4 And that because of false brethren unawares brought in, who came in privily to spy out our liberty which we have in Christ Jesus, that they might bring us into bondage:
- Galatians 3:26 For ye are all the children of God by faith in Christ Jesus.
- Galatians 3:28 There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither bond nor free, there is neither male nor female: for ye are all one in Christ Jesus.
- Galatians 4:14 And my temptation which was in my flesh ye despised not, nor rejected; but received me as an angel of God, *even* as Christ Jesus.
- Galatians 6:15 For in Christ Jesus neither circumcision availeth any thing, nor uncircumcision, but a new creature.
- Ephesians 1:1 ¶ Paul, an apostle of Jesus Christ by the will of God, to the saints which are at Ephesus, and to the faithful in Christ Jesus:
- Ephesians 2:6 And hath raised *us* up together, and made *us* sit together in heavenly *places* in Christ Jesus:
- Ephesians 2:7 That in the ages to come he might shew the exceeding riches of his grace in *his* kindness toward us through Christ Jesus.
- Ephesians 2:10 For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them.
- Ephesians 2:13 But now in Christ Jesus ye who sometimes were far off are made nigh by the blood of Christ.

Philippians 1:1 ¶ Paul and Timotheus, the servants of Jesus Christ, to all the saints in [Christ Jesus](#) which are at Philippi, with the bishops and deacons:
Philippians 2:5 Let this mind be in you, which was also in [Christ Jesus](#):
Philippians 3:3 For we are the circumcision, which worship God in the spirit, and rejoice in [Christ Jesus](#), and have no confidence in the flesh.
Philippians 3:8 Yea doubtless, and I count all things *but* loss for the excellency of the knowledge of [Christ Jesus](#) my Lord: for whom I have suffered the loss of all things, and do count them *but* dung, that I may win Christ,
Philippians 3:12 Not as though I had already attained, either were already perfect: but I follow after, if that I may apprehend that for which also I am apprehended of [Christ Jesus](#).
Philippians 3:14 I press toward the mark for the prize of the high calling of God in [Christ Jesus](#).
Philippians 4:7 And the peace of God, which passeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through [Christ Jesus](#).
Philippians 4:19 But my God shall supply all your need according to his riches in glory by [Christ Jesus](#).
Philippians 4:21 Salute every saint in [Christ Jesus](#). The brethren which are with me greet you.

Colossians 1:4 Since we heard of your faith in [Christ Jesus](#), and of the love *which ye have* to all the saints,
Colossians 1:28 Whom we preach, warning every man, and teaching every man in all wisdom; that we may present every man perfect in [Christ Jesus](#):
Colossians 2:6 As ye have therefore received [Christ Jesus](#) the Lord, *so* walk ye in him:
1 Thessalonians 2:14 For ye, brethren, became followers of the churches of God which in Judaea are in [Christ Jesus](#): for ye also have suffered like things of your own countrymen, even as they *have* of the Jews:
1 Thessalonians 5:18 In every thing give thanks: for this is the will of God in [Christ Jesus](#) concerning you.

1 Timothy 1:12 ¶ And I thank [Christ Jesus](#) our Lord, who hath enabled me, for that he counted me faithful, putting me into the ministry;
1 Timothy 1:14 And the grace of our Lord was exceeding abundant with faith and love which is in [Christ Jesus](#).
1 Timothy 1:15 This *is* a faithful saying, and worthy of all acceptation, that [Christ Jesus](#) came into the world to save sinners; of whom I am chief.
1 Timothy 2:5 For *there is* one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man [Christ Jesus](#):
1 Timothy 3:13 For they that have used the office of a deacon well purchase to themselves a good degree, and great boldness in the faith which is in [Christ Jesus](#).
1 Timothy 6:13 ¶ I give thee charge in the sight of God, who quickeneth all things, and *before* [Christ Jesus](#), who before Pontius Pilate witnessed a good confession;

2 Timothy 1:1 ¶ Paul, an apostle of Jesus Christ by the will of God, according to the promise of life which is in [Christ Jesus](#),
2 Timothy 1:2 To Timothy, *my* dearly beloved son: Grace, mercy, *and* peace, from God the Father and [Christ Jesus](#) our Lord.
2 Timothy 1:9 Who hath saved us, and called *us* with an holy calling, not according to our works, but according to his own purpose and grace, which was given us in [Christ Jesus](#) before the world began,
2 Timothy 1:13 Hold fast the form of sound words, which thou hast heard of me, in faith and love which is in [Christ Jesus](#).
2 Timothy 2:1 ¶ Thou therefore, my son, be strong in the grace that is in [Christ Jesus](#).

2 Timothy 2:10 Therefore I endure all things for the elect's sakes, that they may also obtain the salvation which is in [Christ Jesus](#) with eternal glory.

2 Timothy 3:12 Yea, and all that will live godly in [Christ Jesus](#) shall suffer persecution.

2 Timothy 3:15 And that from a child thou hast known the holy scriptures, which are able to make thee wise unto salvation through faith which is in [Christ Jesus](#).

Philemon 1:6 That the communication of thy faith may become effectual by the acknowledging of every good thing which is in you in [Christ Jesus](#).

Philemon 1:23 There salute thee Epaphras, my fellowprisoner in [Christ Jesus](#);

Hebrews 3:1 ¶ Wherefore, holy brethren, partakers of the heavenly calling, consider the Apostle and High Priest of our profession, [Christ Jesus](#);

1 Peter 5:10 ¶ But the God of all grace, who hath called us unto his eternal glory by [Christ Jesus](#), after that ye have suffered a while, make you perfect, stablish, strengthen, settle *you*.

1 Peter 5:14 Greet ye one another with a kiss of charity. Peace *be* with you all that are in [Christ Jesus](#). Amen.

< 1401> Servant/Bondservant (doulos)

Romans 1:1 Paul, a servant <1401> of Jesus Christ, called *to be* an apostle, separated unto the gospel of God,

Romans 6:16 Know ye not, that to whom ye yield yourselves servants <1401> to obey, his servants <1401> ye are to whom ye obey; whether of sin unto death, or of obedience unto righteousness?

Romans 6:17 But God be thanked, that ye were the servants <1401> of sin, but ye have obeyed from the heart that form of doctrine which was delivered you.

Romans 6:19 I speak after the manner of men because of the infirmity of your flesh: for as ye have yielded your members servants <1401> to uncleanness and to iniquity unto iniquity; even so now yield your members servants <1401> to righteousness unto holiness.

Romans 6:20 For when you were the servants <1401> of sin, you were free from righteousness.

1 Corinthians 7:21 Art thou called *being* a servant <1401>? care not for it: but if thou mayest be made free, use *it* rather.

1 Corinthians 7:22 For he that is called in the Lord, *being* a servant <1401>, is the Lord's freeman: likewise also he that is called, *being* free, is Christ's servant <1401>.

1 Corinthians 7:23 Ye are bought with a price; be not ye the servants <1401> of men.

1 Corinthians 12:13 For by one Spirit are we all baptized into one body, whether *we be* Jews or Gentiles, whether *we be* bond <1401> or free; and have been all made to drink into one Spirit.

2 Corinthians 4:5 For we preach not ourselves, but Christ Jesus the Lord; and ourselves your servants <1401> for Jesus' sake.

Galatians 1:10 ¶ For do I now persuade men, or God? or do I seek to please men? for if I yet pleased men, I should not be the servant <1401> of Christ.

Galatians 3:28 There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither **bond <1401> nor free**, there is neither male nor female: for ye are all one in Christ Jesus.

Galatians 4:1 ¶ Now I say, *That* the heir, as long as he is a child, differeth nothing from a servant <1401>, though he be lord of all;

Galatians 4:7 Wherefore thou art no more a servant <1401>, but a son; and if a son, then an heir of God through Christ.

Ephesians 6:5 Servants <1401>, be obedient to them that are *your* masters according to the flesh, with fear and trembling, in singleness of your heart, as unto Christ;

Ephesians 6:6 Not with eyeservice, as menpleasers; but as the servants <1401> of Christ, doing the will of God from the heart;

Ephesians 6:8 Knowing that whatsoever good thing any man doeth, the same shall he receive of the Lord, whether *he be* bond <1401> or free.

Philippians 1:1 ¶ Paul and Timotheus, the servants <1401> of Jesus Christ, to all the saints in Christ Jesus which are at Philippi, with the bishops and deacons:

Philippians 2:7 But made himself of no reputation, and took upon him the form of a servant <1401>, and was made in the likeness of men:

Colossians 3:11 Where there is neither Greek nor Jew, circumcision nor uncircumcision, Barbarian, Scythian, **bond <1401> nor free**: but Christ *is* all, and in all.

Colossians 3:22 Servants <1401>, obey in all things *your* masters according to the flesh; not with eyeservice, as menpleasers; but in singleness of heart, fearing God:

Colossians 4:1 ¶ Masters, give unto *your* servants <1401> that which is just and equal; knowing that ye also have a Master in heaven.

Colossians 4:12 **Epaphras, who is one of you, a servant <1401> of Christ**, saluteth you, always labouring fervently for you in prayers, that ye may stand perfect and complete in all the will of God.

1 Timothy 6:1 ¶ Let as many servants <1401> as are under the yoke count their own masters worthy of all honour, that the name of God and *his* doctrine be not blasphemed.

2 Timothy 2:24 And the servant <1401> of the Lord must not strive; but be gentle unto all *men*, apt to teach, patient,

Titus 1:1 ¶ Paul, a servant <1401> of God, and an apostle of Jesus Christ, according to the faith of God's elect, and the acknowledging of the truth which is after godliness;

Titus 2:9 *Exhort* servants <1401> to be obedient unto their own masters, *and* to please *them* well in all *things*; not answering again;

Philemon 1:16 Not now as a servant <1401>, but above a servant <1401>, a brother beloved, specially to me, but how much more unto thee, both in the flesh, and in the Lord?

James 1:1 ¶ James, a servant <1401> of God and of the Lord Jesus Christ, to the twelve tribes which are scattered abroad, greeting.

1 Peter 2:16 As free, and not using *your* liberty for a cloke of maliciousness, but as the servants <1401> of God.

2 Peter 1:1 ¶ Simon Peter, a servant <1401> and an apostle of Jesus Christ, to them that have obtained like precious faith with us through the righteousness of God and our Saviour Jesus Christ:

2 Peter 2:19 While they promise them liberty, they themselves are the servants <1401> of corruption: for of whom a man is overcome, of the same is he brought in bondage.

Jude 1:1 ¶ Jude, the servant <1401> of Jesus Christ, and brother of James, to them that are sanctified by God the Father, and preserved in Jesus Christ, *and* called:

Revelation 1:1 ¶ The Revelation of Jesus Christ, which God gave unto him, to shew unto his servants <1401> things which must shortly come to pass; and he sent and signified *it* by his angel unto his servant <1401> John:

Revelation 2:20 Notwithstanding I have a few things against thee, because thou sufferest that woman Jezebel, which calleth herself a prophetess, to teach and to seduce my servants <1401> to commit fornication, and to eat things sacrificed unto idols.

Revelation 6:15 And the kings of the earth, and the great men, and the rich men, and the chief captains, and the mighty men, and every **bondman <1401>**, and every free man, hid themselves in the dens and in the rocks of the mountains;

Revelation 7:3 Saying, Hurt not the earth, neither the sea, nor the trees, till we have sealed the servants <1401> of our God in their foreheads.

Revelation 10:7 But in the days of the voice of the seventh angel, when he shall begin to sound, the mystery of God should be finished, as he hath declared to his servants <1401> the prophets.

Revelation 11:18 And the nations were angry, and thy wrath is come, and the time of the dead, that they should be judged, and that thou shouldest give reward unto thy servants <1401> the prophets, and to the saints, and them that fear thy name, small and great; and shouldest destroy them which destroy the earth.

Revelation 13:16 And he causeth all, both small and great, rich and poor, free and bond <1401>, to receive a mark in their right hand, or in their foreheads:

Revelation 15:3 And they sing the song of Moses the servant <1401> of God, and the song of the Lamb, saying, Great and marvellous *are* thy works, Lord God Almighty; just and true *are* thy ways, thou King of saints.

Revelation 19:2 For true and righteous *are* his judgments: for he hath judged the great whore, which did corrupt the earth with her fornication, and hath avenged the blood of his servants <1401> at her hand.

Revelation 19:5 ¶ And a voice came out of the throne, saying, Praise our God, all ye his servants [<1401>](#), and ye that fear him, both small and great.

Revelation 19:18 That ye may eat the flesh of kings, and the flesh of captains, and the flesh of mighty men, and the flesh of horses, and of them that sit on them, and the flesh of all *men*, both free and bond [<1401>](#), both small and great.

Revelation 22:3 And there shall be no more curse: but the throne of God and of the Lamb shall be in it; and his servants [<1401>](#) shall serve him:

Revelation 22:6 ¶ And he said unto me, These sayings *are* faithful and true: and the Lord God of the holy prophets sent his angel to shew unto his servants [<1401>](#) the things which must shortly be done.

<1098> Prisoner

Matthew 27:15 Now at *that* feast the governor was wont to release unto the people a prisoner [<1198>](#), whom they would.

Matthew 27:16 And they had then a notable prisoner [<1198>](#), called Barabbas.

Mark 15:6 Now at *that* feast he released unto them one prisoner [<1198>](#), whomsoever they desired.

Acts 16:25 ¶ And at midnight Paul and Silas prayed, and sang praises unto God: and the prisoners [<1198>](#) heard them.

Acts 16:27 And the keeper of the prison awaking out of his sleep, and seeing the prison doors open, he drew out his sword, and would have killed himself, supposing that the prisoners [<1198>](#) had been fled.

Acts 23:18 So he took him, and brought *him* to the chief captain, and said, Paul the prisoner [<1198>](#) called me unto *him*, and prayed me to bring this young man unto thee, who hath something to say unto thee.

Acts 25:14 And when they had been there many days, Festus declared Paul's cause unto the king, saying, There is a certain man left in bonds [<1198>](#) by Felix:

Acts 25:27 For it seemeth to me unreasonable to send a prisoner [<1198>](#), and not withal to signify the crimes *laid* against him.

Acts 28:16 And when we came to Rome, the centurion delivered the prisoners [<1198>](#) to the captain of the guard: but Paul was suffered to dwell by himself with a soldier that kept him.

Acts 28:17 ¶ And it came to pass, that after three days Paul called the chief of the Jews together: and when they were come together, he said unto them, Men *and* brethren, though I have committed nothing against the people, or customs of our fathers, yet was I delivered prisoner [<1198>](#) from Jerusalem into the hands of the Romans.

Ephesians 3:1 ¶ For this cause I Paul, the prisoner [<1198>](#) of Jesus Christ for you Gentiles,

Ephesians 4:1 ¶ I therefore, the prisoner [<1198>](#) of the Lord, beseech you that ye walk worthy of the vocation wherewith ye are called,

2 Timothy 1:8 Be not thou therefore ashamed of the testimony of our Lord, nor of me his prisoner [<1198>](#): but be thou partaker of the afflictions of the gospel according to the power of God;

Philemon 1:1 ¶ Paul, a prisoner [<1198>](#) of Jesus Christ, and Timothy *our* brother, unto Philemon our dearly beloved, and fellowlabourer,

Philemon 1:9 Yet for love's sake I rather beseech *thee*, being such an one as Paul the aged, and now also a prisoner [<1198>](#) of Jesus Christ.

Hebrews 13:3 Remember them that are in bonds [<1198>](#), as bound with them; *and* them which suffer adversity, as being yourselves also in the body.

<1099> Bonds/Shackles/Chains

- Mark 7:35 And straightway his ears were opened, and the string <1199> of his tongue was loosed, and he spake plain.
- Luke 8:29 (For he had commanded the unclean spirit to come out of the man. For oftentimes it had caught him: and he was kept bound with chains and in fetters; and he brake the bands <1199>, and was driven of the devil into the wilderness.)
- Luke 13:16 And ought not this woman, being a daughter of Abraham, whom Satan hath bound, lo, these eighteen years, be loosed from this bond <1199> on the sabbath day?
- Acts 16:26 And suddenly there was a great earthquake, so that the foundations of the prison were shaken: and immediately all the doors were opened, and every one's bands <1199> were loosed.
- Acts 20:23 Save that the Holy Ghost witnesseth in every city, saying that bonds <1199> and afflictions abide me.
- Acts 22:30 On the morrow, because he would have known the certainty wherefore he was accused of the Jews, he loosed him from *his* bands <1199>, and commanded the chief priests and all their council to appear, and brought Paul down, and set him before them.
- Acts 23:29 Whom I perceived to be accused of questions of their law, but to have nothing laid to his charge worthy of death or of bonds <1199>.
- Acts 26:29 And Paul said, I would to God, that not only thou, but also all that hear me this day, were both almost, and altogether such as I am, except these bonds <1199>.
- Acts 26:31 And when they were gone aside, they talked between themselves, saying, This man doeth nothing worthy of death or of bonds <1199>.
- Philippians 1:7 ¶ Even as it is meet for me to think this of you all, because I have you in my heart; inasmuch as both in my bonds <1199>, and in the defence and confirmation of the gospel, ye all are partakers of my grace.
- Philippians 1:13 So that my bonds <1199> in Christ are manifest in all the palace, and in all other *places*;
- Philippians 1:14 And many of the brethren in the Lord, waxing confident by my bonds <1199>, are much more bold to speak the word without fear.
- Philippians 1:16 The one preach Christ of contention, not sincerely, supposing to add affliction to my bonds <1199>:
- Colossians 4:18 The salutation by the hand of me Paul. Remember my bonds <1199>. Grace be with you. Amen. <<Written from Rome to Colossians by Tychicus and Onesimus.>>
- 2 Timothy 2:9 Wherein I suffer trouble, as an evil doer, *even* unto bonds <1199>; but the word of God is not bound.
- Philemon 1:10 I beseech thee for my son Onesimus, whom I have begotten in my bonds <1199>:
- Philemon 1:13 Whom I would have retained with me, that in thy stead he might have ministered unto me in the bonds <1199> of the gospel:
- Hebrews 10:34 For ye had compassion of me in my bonds <1199>, and took joyfully the spoiling of your goods, knowing in yourselves that ye have in heaven a better and an enduring substance.
- Hebrews 11:36 And others had trial of *cruel* mockings and scourgings, yea, moreover of bonds <1199> and imprisonment:
- Jude 1:6 And the angels which kept not their first estate, but left their own habitation, he hath reserved in everlasting chains <1199> under darkness unto the judgment of the great day.
