•	Suffering is not always God's punishment or chastisement.	(1 Peter 4:12, 4:19)
•	Suffering takes a terrible toll on body and mind.	(Rom. 8:23, 2 Cor. 5:2)
•	In suffering we have an advocate before the throne of God.	(Heb. 4:16, 1 Jn 2:1)
